## **Priority Registration 2021**

## Parents:

As always, the school will offer priority registration for Summer School and the Fall of 2021 to families with children currently enrolled at the Learning Tree. \*\*This is also the time that you would register any siblings\*\* Priority registration applications must be received by Friday, February 19, 2021 to receive priority status. The system that we use for all of our registrations is not equipped with a re-registration format, so you will need to print the Registration Forms (one for Summer, one for Fall, and one specifically for GRADUATING Pre K students), fill out, and return by the due date – February 19, 2021. \*\*please print one per child\*\*\* Once we have processed your registration, we will provide you with a bill for any Registration Fees and/or Summer School deposits due. Your spot will not be guaranteed until all payments have been made. Last day to make any payments is March 5, 2021. Open registration to the public begins March 8<sup>th</sup> at which time any remaining spaces can be taken.

\*\*GRADUATING PRE K STUDENTS: Due to the new earlier and staggered start dates for the Fall in the school districts, we will offer two Summer School Sessions (Session 1 &2) for our graduating Pre K students. However, we will be offering a weekly daycare option the first 2 weeks of Summer Session 3, for graduating Pre K students who may need it. Please note that the weekly daycare will be billed at the weekly rate, and is for students attending 5 days a week ONLY. You will be responsible for paying for all of the daycare weeks that you sign up for unless you cancel them prior to April 30, 2021. \*There is a separate Summer Registration Form for graduating Pre K students\*.

Every Summer, there is a slight tuition increase to cover cost of living, payroll increases, building improvements, new materials, etc. This year, the increase was a little larger than normal due to the extra costs we have accrued with all of the COVID changes. The new rates which will go into effect beginning Summer Session 1, are also included.

To continue to offer our students the most consistent routine and scheduling, the following options are available for attendance - 5 DAYS (Monday through Friday), 3 DAYS (Monday, Wednesday and Friday), or 2 DAYS (Tuesday and Thursday). We offer HALF DAY (9:00-12:00) and FULL DAY (7:00-6:00) options for any of the three attendance choices.

## **Summer School:**

<u>Summer Session 1</u> -(Registration Fee Per Family: \$40.00 Non-Refundable): June 1 – July 9 (Closed July 5th)

<u>Summer Session 2-</u> (Registration Fee Per Family: \$40.00 Non-Refundable): July 12 – August 6

<u>Summer Session 3</u>-(Registration Fee Per Family: \$40.00 Non-Refundable): August 9 – Sept. 2 (**Closed** on Sept. 3rd for Maintenance)

Summer school is divided into three sessions. The Non-Refundable Registration Fee Per Family for <u>each</u> Summer session is <u>\$40.00</u> (\$120.00 for all three sessions). Summer school is on a first come basis for each age group. There are fewer spaces for enrollment than the regular school year due to teachers taking vacation. When signing up for a session, you are financially responsible for all four weeks' tuition.

In addition to the NON-REFUNDABLE Registration Fee required at sign-up, a \$100.00 deposit per family is also due. This \$100.00 deposit will be credited back to you in the <u>last summer session you registered</u> your child for.

\*\*\*Dropping out of a summer session <u>after</u> April 30, 2021, will result in a forfeiture of the \$100.00 deposit. Full attendance of a session is required in order to be considered for deposit return.

## Fall:

Fall Semester begins Tuesday, September 7, 2021 (Closed September 6, 2021 for Labor Day) There is a \$100.00 Per Student (Non-Refundable) Registration Fee required for returning students. For siblings new to the program, there is a NEW student Registration Fee of \$150.00 (Non-Refundable).

\*For students who are enrolling in Pre-K (4 years old by Sept. 1, 2021), please be reminded that it is a 5 day program in order to assist with Kindergarten readiness. Pre-K aged students, not wishing to attend 5 days, may enroll in the Part-Time Pre-K program that is joined with the oldest Pre School class and is run through the Pre School rotation. Please note that there are a limited number of spaces in that class.
