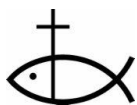

From Fr. Steffl:

An insert in the bulletin this weekend is about the **First Friday and First Saturday devotions**. For those who are not familiar with these, I would like to encourage people to know about them and participate in them. Going to Confession once a month, it is easy to remember the First Friday or First Saturday of the month – that way it is easier to hold one’s self accountable to receiving that Sacrament and not letting it “slip” too long.

This next week, we begin our **new adult education series – Evangelization and Acts of the Apostles in Marshall**. It is a 10-week series, with a DVD presentation and some questions to discuss afterward, similar to the last study we did this autumn on the Eucharist. Each session will be offered 4 different times each week: 3:30 pm Tuesdays (first one on Jan 15th) at Heritage Pointe, 6:30 pm Tuesdays in Carlin Hall (first one Jan 15th), 4 pm Wednesdays at Hill Street Place (first one Jan 16th), and 4 pm Thursdays at Boulder Estates (first one Jan 17th), and everyone is welcome to come to any of the locations.

Coming up next week is the anniversary of the Supreme Court decision *Roe v. Wade*, which legalized abortion in the USA. **The United States Bishops have designated Jan 22 as a day of prayer and penance for our country and for respect for life**. There has been a bus arranged for that day next week (Tuesday) to the annual **March for Life** rally that takes place in St. Paul at the Capitol building and the St. Paul Cathedral. More information is in the bulletin. Please consider taking the opportunity to attend this event. Bishop LeVoir has attached a partial indulgence to those who attend the event from the Diocese of New Ulm with the conditions of

- Proper interior disposition of desire to receive the indulgence.
- Sacramental Confession and Holy Communion (as soon as possible if not on the actual day, January 22).
- Prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father.
- The indulgence is also available to those who are aged, sick, or for any other reason unable to leave their homes, having fulfilled the same conditions, who unite themselves to the prayers that are offered that day for Respect for Life.
- In addition, some other act of penance in reparation for sin committed against life.

A bus will load at Marshall at 6:45 a.m. in the northwest corner of the Market Street Mall parking lot in Marshall. Participants are encouraged to bring a sack lunch and to dress warmly. To reserve your spot, contact Lori Timmerman at 507-476-0070 or email her at timmerman@holy-redeemer.com.
