

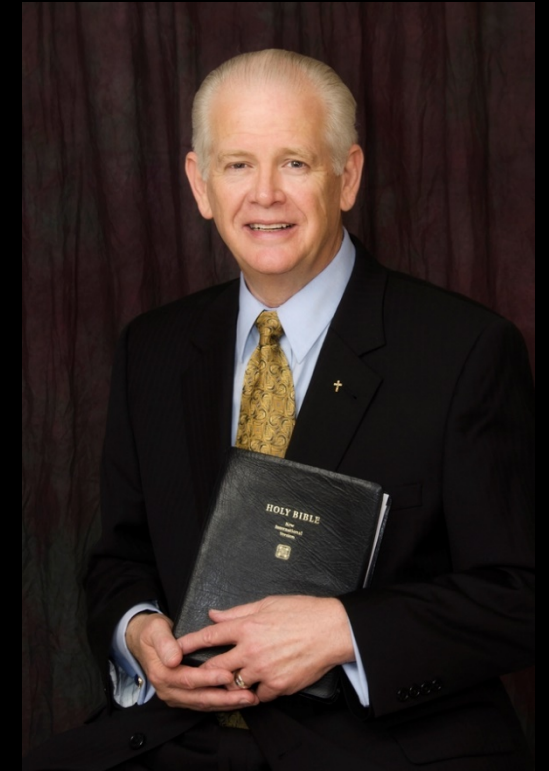

If you forgot your canned goods you can make a donation in the jar on the table in the foyer.

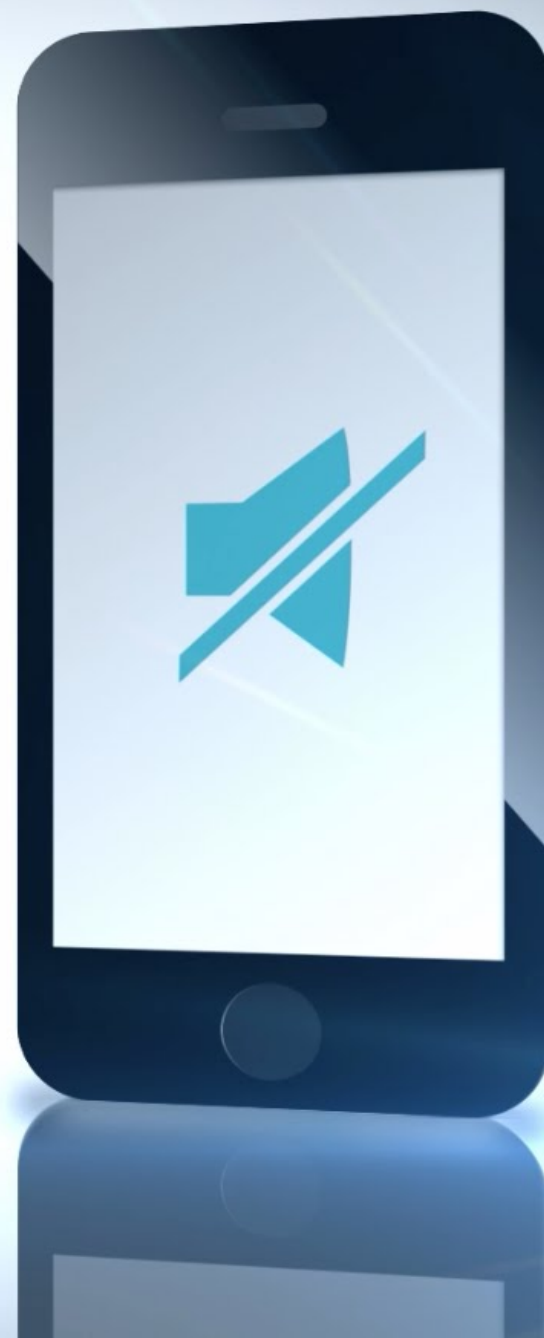
