

"The Power and Meaning of the Prayer that Jesus Taught" (part #2) Matthew 6:5-13

Matthew 6:10 "... Thy kingdom come, THY will to be done, on earth as it is in heaven."

Prayer is VITAL to maintaining and growing our relationship with GOD ---

Therefore it is CRITICAL that we learn HOW and WHAT to pray.

We look then to the Prayer that Jesus taught his disciples ... the Lord's Prayer or many know it as 'The Our Father" ... SO THAT we may learn to pray as we ought ... as Jesus taught.

1st --- HOW SHOULD WE PRAY?

- A. SINCERELY & WITH MEANING
- B. WILLING TO BE FORMED AND TRANSFORMED BY GOD
- C. SPONTANEOUSLY & REGULARLY

2nd ---WHAT TO PRAY?

Jesus prescribes 5 specific prayers within the Lord's Prayer.

Can you identify each?

Many would argue that this week's prayer, "THY KINGDOM COME, THY WILL BE DONE ON EARTH AS IT IS IN HEAVEN." May be the MOST IMPORTANT PRAYER FOUND WITHIN THE "OUR FATHER."

1. WHEN WE PRAY --- DO WE MEAN TO PRAY, "THY & THINE"? or "MY & MINE"?

Hallowed be MY NAME...

MY kingdom come - OR -

MY will be done on earth

Hallowed be THY NAME...

THY kingdom come

THY will be done on earth

2. ARE WE PRAYING FOR HEAVEN TO COME TO EARTH OR FOR US TO ESCAPE TO HEAVEN?

When Jesus came TO EARTH ... the 'kingdom of heaven' also came near (Matthew 4:17) What is heaven like? (Isaiah 11:6-9; Micah 4:3, Isaiah 2:4-5; & Revelation 21:1-5)

3. ARE WE PRAYING THAT WE BECOME THE AGENTS OF GOD SO THAT EARTH MAY BECOME A HEAVENLY OUTPOST SO THAT THE WORLD MAY BE MORE LIKE HEAVEN?

God has called us, as Jesus was sent, --- to 'UNLEASH THE POWER OF HEAVEN UPON EARTH.

WHAT CAN WE DO TODAY TO DO BETTER TOMORROW?

To pray a prayer of offering that we may BE AND DO WHAT GOD INTENDED IN THE BEGINNING.. THAT WE BE AUTHENTIC WOMEN, MEN & CHURCHES --- TO BE AS GOD CREATED US TO BE AND TO LIVE!!!!!
