<u>Presentation of Budget – Fiscal Year 2018-19</u> – Brantley Price, Town Manager, presented the FY 19-20 budget, along with the budget message to the board. The property tax rate will remain the same as FY 2018-19 at \$.42/\$100 in valuation. Brantley then highlighted the following items in each fund:
