In order to receive the DISCOUNTED RATE, tuition payment must be submitted on or before the scheduled due date. Tuition dates are always on Mondays (unless otherwise listed), so if your child's regular attendance schedule is ONLY Tuesday/Thursday, you may make your payment the next day on the Tuesday, and still be eligible for the discount. Any payments received after that date will be billed at the REGULAR TUITION RATE. Tuition due dates can be found in your monthly newsletters (which can also be found on our website on the Parent Corner page), reminders will be posted in the foyer the week before tuition is due, and you will receive an email with your tuition statement prior to the due date. Please make sure to confirm that we have the correct email address to avoid any confusion or missed messages. You may always take advantage of the option to turn in a Post-Dated check before the tuition is actually due to avoid any possibilities of being late.

Reminder that if you or your child are not feeling well, or if you have had any recent exposure to COVID, please do not come to the school. We are trying to stay as healthy as possible and appreciate all the help you have given us to do so! Additionally, anyone over the age of 2 MUST wear a mask when they enter the building. Please make sure to keep extra masks in your child's bin so that they are available to them throughout the day. If you are bringing a sibling with you to drop off or pick up, they MUST wear their mask and stay with you at the Drop Zones.

At drop off time, please walk your student all the way to the drop zone and confirm with a teacher that you are dropping them off before you leave. At pick up time, once you have taken your child from the teachers, please always keep them with you. Please discourage them from going to the front door unless you are with them.

During the week of January 10-14, teachers will be evaluating the students' progress from this last semester. Progress Reports will go home the following week. These Progress Reports are yours to keep and do not need to be returned to school. A second round of evaluations will take place in late May and end of year assessments will be sent home in June.

Despite the chilly temperatures, we are staying outside in the late afternoons. Please be sure to bring an extra jacket for your student so they can bundle up when need be. LABEL EVERYTHING! As a reminder, we do not have extra jackets or clothes to loan out to the kids.
