- B – Park Vandalized – Friday or Saturday night, foul language was written (spray-painted) on the porta-johns and dugouts. There was also some damage done to nearby hunting shacks and blinds.
- C – Cemetery – Peterman to assist sexton in setting foundations before winter. Leyrer motions to close the cemetery from December 1<sup>st</sup> until March 1<sup>st</sup>, weather depending (for burial). Welder seconds. All in favor. Carried.
- D – Jed – Requesting Walters removal from office citing: Refusal to do her job; Refusal to do jobs that were not her statutory duty that the prior Clerk performed; Unprofessional conduct. Effective immediately. Welder so motions. Leyrer seconds. All in favor (Walters excluded). As the Board does not have the power to remove an official, this motion cannot be carried.
