**LAST CALL, or AGED TO PERFECTION**

Workmen to-day, in tearing out a wall in the [Marion Co.] Court House for the purpose of placing in a large vault door leading to the new addition of the building, found a quart bottle of rare old whiskey, which was deposited in a cavity of the wall during the construction of the building in 1859. The bottle was securely sealed, yet considerable of the liquor had evaporated, but about two-thirds of it remained. The builder, "Uncle" Tom Spencer, will save a portion of the liquor and place it in the walls of the new building to be resurrected by future generations.
