

JESSIE T. CALVIN

1918 - 1989

Jessie T. Calvin, age 71 of Bay Port, passed away Friday, Dec. 8 at Huron Memorial Hospital in Bad Axe following a six-month illness.

He was born April 13, 1918 in Hopkinsville, Kentucky, son of the late Cleveland and Marcella (Hurt) Calvin. He married Irene May Howard on April 13, 1959 in Port Huron. She survives him.

Mr. Calvin had been employed for the R.E.A. in Detroit for 15 years before retiring 15 years ago. They had lived in Hazel Park before moving to Bay Port in 1980.

He served in the U.S. Army during World War II and had been awarded the Silver Star.

He was a member of the Faith Bible Baptist Church in Bay Port; the Royal Oak Lodge #464 F.&A.M. and the Steele-Lambert American Legion Post #533 of Bay Port.

Surviving are his wife, Irene Calvin of Bay Port; one brother, Rev. D. Calvin, Royal Oak; three sisters, Mrs. Opal Powell, Seattle, Wash., Mrs. Lois Dukes, Milwaukee, Wisc. and Mrs. Mervin (Pearline) Utley, Hopkinsville, Kentucky and several nieces and nephews.

Two brothers, Dallas Calvin in 1966 and Earl Calvin on Nov. 13, 1989, preceded him in death.

Funeral services took place Monday, Dec. 11 at 11 a.m. at the Dinkel-Juengel Funeral Home, Sebawaing. Rev. D. Calvin and Rev. David W. Ballard officiated with burial in the Caseville Township Cemetery.

The Northern Star Lodge #277 F.&A.M. of Sebawaing conducted a service at the funeral home on Sunday evening. The American Legion Post #533 of Bay Port conducted graveside services at the cemetery.
