

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER
MONITORING REQUIREMENTS NOT MET FOR**

We are required to monitor your drinking water on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. Between 1/1/2019 and 12/31/2019, we failed to submit the required samples as indicated below and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

What should I do?

What happened? What is being done?

The required number of samples were taken within the sampling period and all samples were below the MCL. A sample testing site was changed due to a property being vacant. The change in location was not approved prior to the sample being collected, causing this violation. The sample site has been changed in the approved sampling plan.
