

## R. BEATRICE SHAND 1897 - 1997

R. Beatrice Shand, age 100, died Friday at her home on Sand Point.

She was born November 19, 1897 in Imlay City, only daughter of the late Alvin and Ethel (Thorpe) Cheney.

On March 29, 1921 she was united in marriage to Edmund H. Shand in Flint. He preceded her in death November 21, 1963. Together they started, owned and operated Shand Radio Specialties, a wholesale/retail electronic store, in Flint. In the early sixties they retired to the cottage they had owned on Sand Point since 1955.

Mrs. Shand was a member of the Caseville United Methodist Church. She was a very active person and enjoyed taking care of her home, yard and garden. She was very proud that she had passed her driver's license test and renewed her license this fall.

Surviving are her sister-in-law, Gwen Cheney of Flint; two nieces, Joan (James) Fleser of Bloomfield Hills and Sharon (William) Timmins of Woodstock, IL; her nephew, Nelson "Bud" Cheney of Imlay City; one great nephew; four great nieces and four great great nephews. Her brother, Nelson Cheney, preceded her in death on June 7, 1996.
