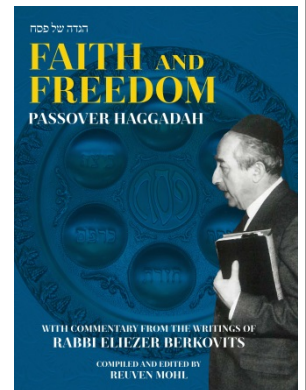

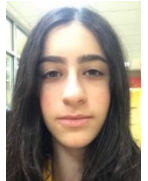
## Youth News
