## Rules 2018 Theme: "MY HOMETOWN HERO"

- I. This contest is open to students from 4th through 12th grades. Entries will be separated into Junior (4th-8th grades) and Senior (9th-12th grades) age divisions.
- II. Entries must have been written by the participant and should be an original work of fiction.
- III. All entries must be labeled with the participants name, school and grade.
- IV. Entries must be between 250 and 1000 words and must be typed. Each student may enter only one time.
- V. There is no charge for this event, however, an entry form is required for each entry.
- VI. All entry <u>forms</u> must be received by the <u>Habersham County Extension</u> Office by September 3, 2018. Forms may be faxed to 706-754-5611. You may mail them to <u>555 Monroe St., Box 13 Unit 50, Clarkesville, GA 30523</u>. Mailed entries must be postmarked by August 24, 2018. Or you may drop them off at that address between 8:00-12:00 and 1:00-5:00 Monday-Friday.
- VII. If any entry is deemed inappropriate by the fair committee or its representatives, that entry will be removed from the judging and from the display area.
- VIII. Students will receive free admission the night of the contest, Saturday, September 8, 2018. His or her name will be at the admission gate ONLY on the night of the contest.
- IX. The Fair Committee reserves the right to cancel this competition if there is a lack of participation
- X. Entries <u>MUST</u> be delivered to the Habersham County Extension Office no later than September 3, 2018. Entries may also be attached to an email and sent directly to Andy Haygood at <u>agentandy4h@gmail.com</u> if a printer is not available. E-mailed entries must be in either .PDF, .DOC, or .RTF formats. <u>CREATIVE WRITING ENTRIES</u> WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AT THE FAIRGROUNDS. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- XI. The Fair Committee will not be responsible for lost or stolen entries.
- XII. Entry into fair contests provides the entrant free admission to the fair on Saturday, September 8, 2018. Multiple entries does not equal multiple admissions. Parents and other family or friends will not be admitted free of charge.
- XIII. All entries become property of the Chattahoochee Mountain Fair and may be subject to destruction, use in promotional materials, or any other use deemed fit by the fair committee.
