Recent polls have shown a significant increase in the percentage of gun owners, the amount of gun ownership, and acceptance of the utility of firearms for self-defense. Some of the increase comes from record and sustained high levels of firearms sales. Some of the higher numbers are from gun owners who are "coming out of the closet." They are examples of a changed attitude and increased acceptance of admitting to firearms ownership in public.

In the United States, gun ownership is the most widespread of any country on the earth.

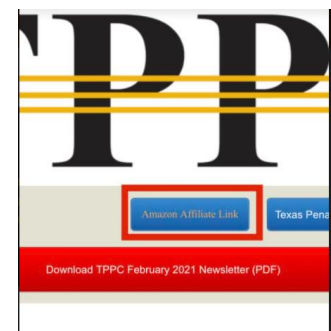
Guns owned in the United States are seldom registered. The few states with laws requiring registration have large populations of resisters who refuse to comply with new registration requirements. Registration requirements are a recent phenomenon. For these reasons, the number of guns in the United States and the number of gun owners are impossible to know with precision. A reasonable estimate of the total number of privately owned guns is about half a billion, 1 and 1/2 guns for every person in the United States, and nearly two guns for every adult in the United States.

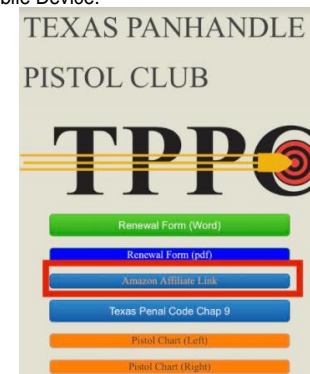

NRA Armed Citizen from December 2023 Magazine

On Sept. 28 in Arlington, Texas, a car dealership erupted into chaos when a former employee allegedly began firing a rifle in the new-car area, making his way to the service area. One current employee told reporters, "I heard one of my friends say, 'Hey, he has a gun.' I look up and look him right in the face and he has a blank, very calm face." Another current employee drew his own firearm and returned fire, stopping the attack and causing the assailant to retreat to the parking lot. Police arrived shortly thereafter and, since the suspect reportedly continued to act aggressively, shot and wounded him. The suspect faces at least two counts of aggravated assault against a public servant and one count of aggravated assault with a deadly weapon. Texas is a constitutional carry state. (nbcdfw.com; Ft. [Incremental Strategy to Reform & Repeal the National Firearms Act](#)

Incremental movement is happening to dismantle the National Firearms Act (NFA), bit by bit. The ultimate goal is repeal.

Here is how it is being done, and what needs to be done in the future.

Educate Gun Culture & The General Public
The first step is well underway. It is to educate the gun culture and the general public about the history and failure of the National Firearms Act. When people learn the history and the effects of the act, support for it evaporates.

Overwhelm The NFA System With Compliance
The second step, again, well underway, is to overwhelm the system with compliance. Take NFA Apart Piece by Piece

The third incremental step is to attack the NFA part by part. The weakest link in the NFA is the tax and regulation of silencers.

The final step should be the repeal of the NFA as antithetical to the Second Amendment. The Supreme Court is a follower, not a leader, in protecting the Bill of Rights. When activists and states make enough progress showing the insanity of the NFA, the courts will eventually follow.

[NICS Black Friday Gun Sales Numbers Hit Record High](#)

Figures compiled by federal regulators from last weekend showed a new record in national gun sale numbers for the busiest shopping day of the year.

The Federal Bureau of Investigation's National Instant Criminal Background Check System processed 214,913 background checks on Black Friday, as detailed by the National Shooting Sports Foundation. This is an 11-percent bump from last year's figures of 192,749 and shattered the previous Black Friday record, set in 2017, of 203,086.

The day will rank third on the NICS "Top 10 Highest Days" list behind two days in March 2021 that came just after the COVID lockdowns were declared.

"The background checks reported by the FBI are in keeping with the trends NSSF has seen throughout the year," said Joe Bartozzi, NSSF President and CEO.

With firearm sales remaining consistently strong, with over a million per month for more than four years running, Bartozzi stressed, "These figures tell us that there is a continued strong appetite for lawful firearm ownership by law-abiding Americans and that firearm manufacturers across the country continue to deliver the quality firearms our customers have come to expect."
