FREEDOM OF INFORMATION POLICY

The Board of Trustees of the Palos Fire Protection District (the "District") pursuant to Illinois Revised Statutes, have the power to pass all "Rules and Regulations of the fire protection District for carrying into effect the objects for which the District was formed."

The Board of Trustees of Palos Fire Protection District in furtherance of the objects for which the District was formed, and to facilitate access by the public to the records maintained by the District hereby adopts as its Freedom of Information Act Policy, 5 ILCS 140, et seq, Freedom of Information Act as if set forth in its entirety.

The Chief of Palos Fire Protection District will implement the policy so that Palos Fire Protection District complies with the Act through execution of the District's Policy hereby adopted and to become effective January 1, 2010.

Furthermore, the Freedom of Information Act Policy adopted by Palos Fire Protection District on November 10, 1992, is repealed.
