

Board Notes – Dec 7, 2018

Renters Report

Director Jan Scott reported Saratoga has 7 lease/rental/guest applications at this time.

Painting of Garage and Front Door

This item was tabled. Doors will be installed at the intended homeowners' units and inspection will be forthcoming.

Website Transfer

The board approved purchasing a prepaid credit card to pay for the cost of and transfer of the Saratoga website, which will be transferred to the association.

Document Update

Action on the document update was tabled until the association's attorney lets the committee know how recent Florida legislation affects the proposed Saratoga document updates.

Electronic Voting

The board unanimously approved using electronic voting. After being trained on SenEarthCo, the board unanimously voted to present and explain the program to homeowners at the annual meeting. SenEarthCo is a computerized program that will provide owners with information concerning Saratoga.
