- b. <u>Barbara Clinger/Elizabeth Madden Scholarship</u>. A minimum of \$500 scholarship awarded **2. Summer Music Camp Scholarship**:

\$300 presented for the purpose of attending a summer music camp.

3. Senior Awards: \$100 awards presented only to graduating high school students of Senior Club members.

All recipients must perform in the scholarship awards ceremony on May 5th, 2018 @ 3:00 pm at NWFSC, Niceville, FL, Tyler Recital Hall.

Rules for Video submission:

- 1. Applicant should wear dress clothing (dress, dress pants and shirt, tie, etc..)
- 2. Please consider the background of your video. It should not distract from your audition.
- Solos that are written with an accompaniment, the accompaniment instrument must be performed live such as (piano, organ, etc....) Pre-recorded accompaniments (sound tracks) not accepted.

Rules for Mp3 (sound only) submission:

- 1. Solos that are written with an **accompaniment**, the accompaniment instrument must be **performed live** such as (piano, organ, etc....)
- 2. The audition recording will consist of pieces from different periods (Baroque, Classical, Romantic or Contemporary). Note: 3 pieces for College Scholarships and 2 pieces for the Summer Music Camp Scholarship.

RULES FOR ALL TYPES OF SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS

- 1. Must submit both: a written application form (see website to download form) AND the audition video or sound recording.
- 2. All scholarship and senior awards recipients are required to perform at the Scholarship Awards Ceremony in May5th at 3:00 pm at NWFSC, Niceville, FL Tyler Recital Hall.
- 3. Applicant must have studied with their present teacher for at least 6 months by April 1st of the current year.
- 4. All applicants must be a United States citizen.
- 5. Awarded Scholarships must be used within the period of one year from the date awarded. In the event of non-usage of the money during this period, the money (or monies) will be returned to the club treasury.
- 6. For the Fred Semasko/Choctaw Bay Music Club Scholarship, the receipient must complete the on-line "Basic Finances 4 All" course. The funds are disbursed by First Command Educational Foundation directly to the college/university.
- 7. For the Barbara Clinger/Elizabeth Madden Scholarship and the Summer Music Camp Scholarships, Choctaw Bay Music Club will disburse the funds directly to the recipient.
