RULES AND REGULATIONS

- No riding double except for adults with young children.
- Stay off the pavement where possible and away from traffic.
- No riding bareback, trick riding or roping. No littering, cursing or fighting.
- No firearms and NO DRINKING HORSEBACK.
- Uncontrollable horses are not allowed on the ride. Red ribbons will be furnished for horses that kick.
- All pets MUST be kept on a leash.
- Those that will be moving vehicles are asked to drive safely. Vehicles are not allowed to follow the ride.
- Keep all campfires small and extinguish them before leaving.
- Parents should make sure their child has an adult to ride with, appropriate clothing and a place to stay at night.
- Bring your raincoats.
- Bring water buckets, as there are not any watering troughs.
- Park your rig in a manner that will not allow your horse to damage any vehicles or other animals.
- Generators should be muffled and of reasonable noise level.
- Do not play loud music when staying up late at night.
- Unruly riders may be asked to leave this ride.
- ABSOLUTELY NO Tying to Fences.
- Keep horses away from van and all wagons.

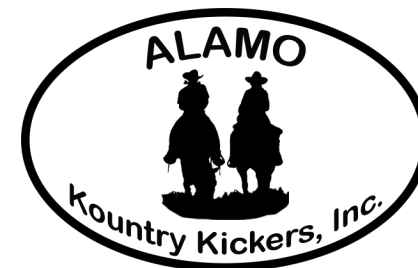

Itinerary

This year we will begin our ride at the Hill Country Youth Exhibition Center in Kerrville TX. To get to the HCYEC, from IH-10 go south (toward Kerrville) on Sidney Baker Boulevard (Hwy 16) go 3/10 of a mile to loop 534. Turn left on the loop and go 4.1 miles to Hwy 27. Turn left and go approx. 1/4 mile to the HCYEC on the right.

Lunches are provided on Saturday, Sunday, Wednesday, and Thursday. You will need to pack a lunch on Monday, Tuesday, and Friday..

Evening meals will be provided on Saturday, Sunday, Monday, and Thursday!

Friday – Feb 2nd Registration begins at approx 6:00 p.m.

Hotel rooms are available in Kerrville at riders cost.

Saturday – Feb. 3rd Cattle Call: 6:30am Bus Leaves at 7:30am Ride out at 9:00 a.m. to Comfort. Lunch provided Patsy and Gary Metting. Camp under the twin bridges of IH-10. **Dinner at 6:00 pm Dinner catered by Buzzy BBQ**

Arrive 4:00 pm / 19 miles

Sunday – Feb 4th Cattle Call: 6:00am Bus Leaves at 7:15am Ride out at 8:45 a.m. to Boerne. Lunch will be provided on the trail, (Sandwiches) Camp at the **Kendall County Fair Grounds**, (210) 249-2839. Dinner by the **Cowboy Church in Boerne** served at 6:00 pm.

Arrive 4:00 pm / 18 miles

Monday – Feb 5th Cattle Call: 5:30am Bus Leaves at 7:00am Ride out at 8:30 am to Cibolo Livery on Obst Road near Bulverde. Lunch will be on the trail, and you will need to pack a lunch. Dinner is provided for the evening by Patsy and Gary Metting, Daddy O Mexican Restaurant, transportation provided .

Arrive 3:30 pm / 19 miles

Tuesday – Feb. 6th Cattle Call: 7:30am Ride out at 9:00 am for a Round Robin. We should be in camp at 12:00pm. Dinner will be on your own and there are local restaurants to eat at.

Wednesday – Feb. 7th Cattle Call: 5:30am Bus Leaves at 7:00am Ride out at 8:00 am to the

Hanging Tree Saloon, (210) 651-5812 in Bracken. Ride on back roads. Lunch furnished by **Mary Trant**. No evening meal. Food is available at the Hanging Tree Saloon or local restaurants.

Free dance for all, bring your friends at the Hanging Tree Saloon. Awards will be given out that night at the dance. AKK Raffle items will also be given away at the dance.

Arrive 4:30 pm / 22 miles

Thursday – Feb. 8th Cattle Call: 6:00am Bus Leaves at 7:30am Ride out at 8:45 am to the night stop at Quality Truck & trailer on FM 1516. Lunch will be at Schertz Park and lunch will be provided by the city of Schertz. Dinner at 6:00pm, and this evening meal will be a pot luck dinner.

Arrive 3:30 pm / 19 miles

Friday – Feb. 9th Cattle Call: 6:30am. Bus leaves at 8:00am . Ride out at 9:00.

We will arrive at our camp site down the road in Martinez.

Arrive 11:00 / 8 miles

< Campsites- Please pick up your hay, manure, and trash at each campsite!>

End of trail ride barbecue and dance will be at the Martinez Dancehall. Free to all registered riders.

The gate pass will get you into the grounds only! It will NOT allow entrance to the rodeo or any performances..
