Re-Launch Church UPDATED June 27TH

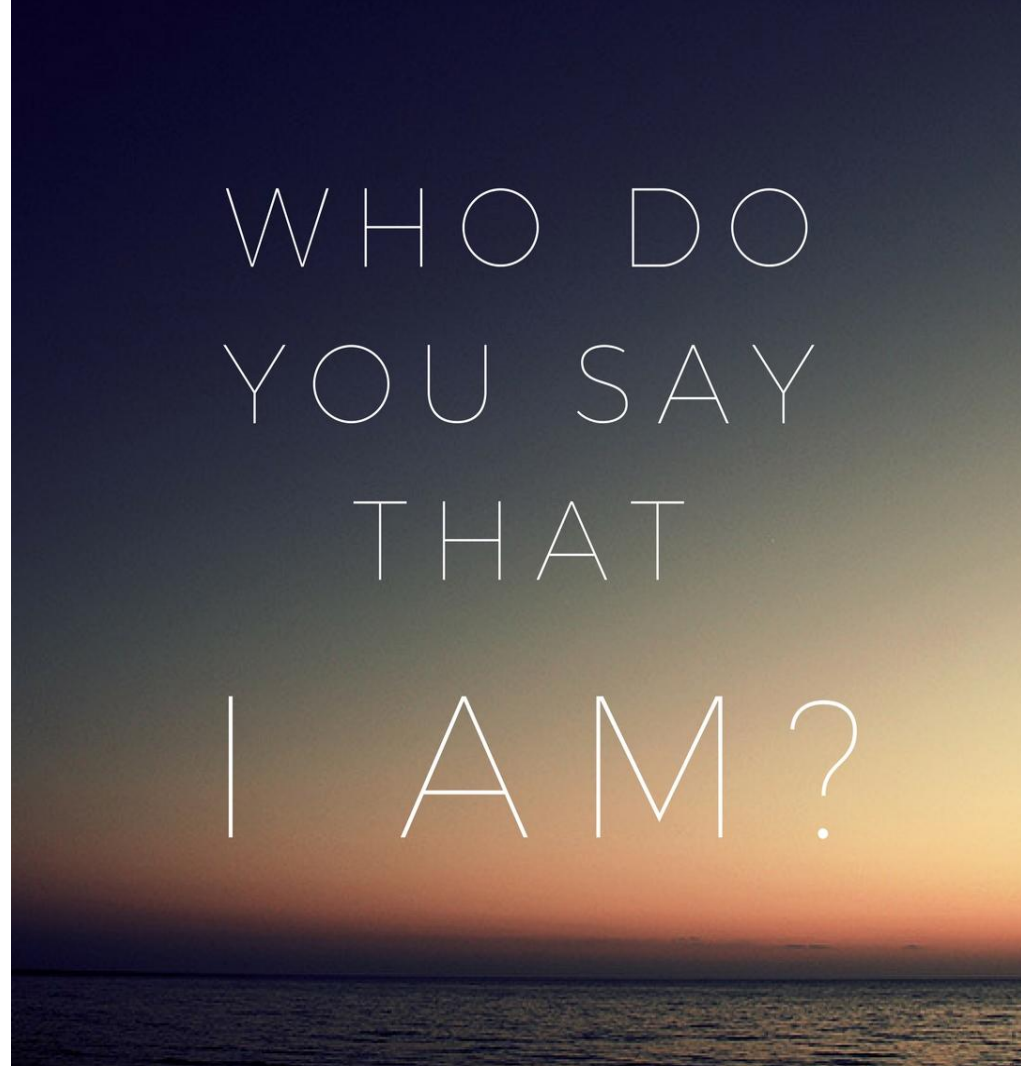
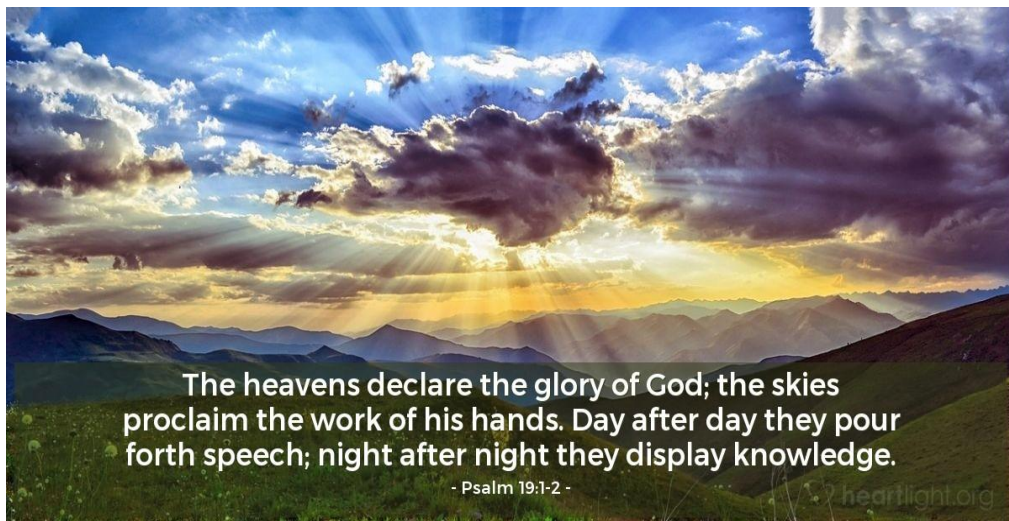
- 1- Entry is still through Sanctuary door **ONLY***.
