**We invite all artists, artisans, and craftspersons to apply for admission to exhibit. All entries must be received on or before Wednesday, September 20, 2017.**

## **Exhibitor (independent artist/craftsperson) information:**

- All entries are juried by the Carmel Mission Fiesta committee.
- A minimum of three (3) photos of work and 1 photo of booth display must be submitted with application.
- Exhibitors are responsible for their works and products.
- Exhibitors must have a valid CA reseller's permit. Please attach a copy.
- Exhibitors set up from 6 a.m. to 9 a.m. the day of the event.
- Exhibitors must provide their own displays (easels, canopies, etc.).
- Displays must be contained within the dimensions of exhibitor's rented space – multiple spaces may be rented.
- Space rental fees are:
  - A) **\$75 plus donation of 10% of total sales** (on honor system) per 5'x12' space in the Mission corridors;
  - B) **\$125 plus donation of 10% of total sales** (on honor system) per 10'x10' space in the open courtyard.
- Spaces are reserved and assigned when payment is received, on a first-come-first-served basis.
- **No** electricity is available.
- **No** nails or tape may be used on building surfaces.
- **No** vehicle, camper or RV parking are allowed on Mission grounds before or during the event.
- Absolutely **NO** PETS.
- Junipero Serra School, the Carmel Mission, and/or the Diocese of Monterey shall not be liable for any loss or damage incurred. All exhibitors shall hold harmless all persons associated with the Carmel Mission Fiesta and indemnify them against any legal proceedings that may arise.
