- 5. Annual Audit Review by Saunders
  - a. Jim Saunders provided an overview of the audit. He reported that no issues were found and the District is well run fiscally.

    - i. Alternative 457b Pension & Benefit Board
      - 1. Innes & Associates have liquidated all invested funds
      - 2. \$3500 deposit required prior to completing final accounting and individual account values.
      - 3. Innes & Associates was asked for proposal for final compilation and accounting and tax statements to close.
    - ii. PSPRS Board Meeting held January 16th



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- 1. PSPRS was asked questions regarding the medical disability retirement case.
  - a. Mike summarized the discussions.
  - b. The Local PSPRS Board approved a motion to have a medical exam performed within 90 days.
  - c. PSPRS training will be on March 6, 2024 in Phoenix. Three members of the Board, maybe 4, will attend.
