**ORDINANCE #197 (B)**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF LATAH ESTABLISHING A POLICY  
FOR THE USE OF FIREWORKS


BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council for the Town of Latah, Spokane County, State of Washington as follows:


Section 1. FIREWORKS ON JULY 2<sup>ND</sup>, 3<sup>RD</sup>, 4<sup>TH</sup>, AND 5<sup>TH</sup>, New Years Eve/Day and Memorial Day ONLY: It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, directly or indirectly to detonate, use, explode or display any fire crackers, sky rockets, Roman candles, or other kinds of fireworks and noise making devices, except on July 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5<sup>th</sup>. New Years Eve/Day and Memorial Day each and every year unless a permit is issued by the town council. Anyone wishing to let off fireworks for a special occasion can come before the town council to request a permit.

Section 2. COMMON FIREWORKS ONLY: All fireworks are prohibited except common fireworks and special fireworks for which a state permit has been issued pursuant to RCW ch.70.77.

Section 3. FIREWORKS CAN BE BANNED: If the weather conditions do not permit fireworks be safely used, the town council may ban use during above stated days. Notification will be advertised of said council decision.
