- Spell out the disciplinary measures to be imposed for the issuance of red and yellow cards or other improper conduct;
- indicate what procedures will be followed regarding protests and appeals;
- indicate that all disciplinary measures imposed by hosting organizations shall be limited to placing restrictions upon an individual's group participation in the tournament/games;
- record the issuance of all red and yellow cards and other matters involving the conduct of a team, its players, coaches, and supporters and also report them immediately to the home State Association and the home club/league of the team; and
- state that the home State Association or member thereof and the home club or league shall, except in the case of referee assault or abuse, have the responsibility for imposing, should circumstances warrant, additional penalties within their respective jurisdictions with regard to any matters arising from the tournament or games.

TOURNAMENT CANCELLATION: We agree that our tournament or game rules shall state what refunds, if any, shall be made to participating teams if all or a portion of the tournament or games is cancelled by the hosting organization for any reason.

POST TOURNAMENT OR GAMES REPORT: We agree that we shall file any required Post Tournament or Games Report with the State Association or Affiliate granting us permission to host this tournament or games within 30 days after the conclusion of the tournament or games. We understand that failure to file the report may preclude the tournament/games host from receiving approval for any tournament/games for the following seasonal years until the report is filed. The Post Tournament or Games Report shall include the following information:

- the number of teams participating in each age group (boys and girls);
- if a champion is determined, the name of the champion for each group;
- the number of teams from each State Association, Affiliate, other Organization Member, or foreign country;
- if "Sportsmanship Awards" are given, the criteria for the award and to whom awards were given;
- the number of fields used for the tournament/games;
- the name of the sponsor, if any; and
- the names and teams of all players issued red and yellow cards, and details of any other matters involving the improper or unsporting conduct of a team, its players, coaches or supporters. **NOTE: Any incident of referee assault or referee abuse by a player, coach, manager, club official, or game official must be reported to the alleged offender's home State Association, or member thereof immediately, but in no event later than 48 hours after an incident of referee assault or abuse..**

TOURNAMENT OR GAMES HOSTING AGREEMENT

In consideration of permission being granted to KASL (KINGSTON AREA SOCCER LEAGUE) to hold a tournament or games at HUDSON VALLEY SPORTS DOME MILTON NY
(Hosting Organization) (City) (State)

On the dates of FEB 31ST / MARCH 1ST 20 20, we agree to the following conditions:

ABIDE BY RULES: We shall abide by all statements made in our approved US Youth Soccer *Application to Host A Tournament or Games*, in our tournament invitation, in our tournament rules, in the US Youth Soccer *Travel and Tournament Policy* and in this US Youth Soccer *Tournament or Games Hosting Agreement*. We agree that all decisions regarding acceptance of teams into a tournament shall be fairly and impartially made and shall not be based upon race, creed, color or national origin and that we will not advertise by any means the tournament or games until all approvals are received.

INVITATIONS: The tournament or games approval form shall accompany all tournament or games invitations distributed.

HOUSING: We agree that we will not require a team to use only accommodations approved or provided by the hosting organization or other organization, unless disclosure is made on the tournament application form of the required hotel/motel names and the guaranteed rates.

PROCURING LIABILITY INSURANCE: We have procured liability insurance coverage for the tournament or games with limits of not less than \$1,000,000/\$2,000,000 which names the State Association or Affiliate with which the Hosting Organization is a member. A copy of the certificate of insurance, IF REQUIRED, is attached issued by ENYUSA

REQUIRING MEDICAL AUTHORIZATIONS: We shall require all teams participating in the tournament or games to provide medical releases for each player in an appropriate form. These authorizations shall be reviewed by the Hosting Organization at registration and kept in the possession of a team official

ADVANCE PUBLICATION OF RULES: We agree that our tournament or games rules shall be included with the invitation sent to each team and shall, again, be published to all teams accepted prior to the start of the tournament/games.

CREDENTIALS CHECKS: We agree that we shall conduct credentials checks to ensure that all players are registered with US Youth Soccer or US Soccer or a member thereof or their national association, properly rostered with their team, and participating in accordance with representations set forth on the US Youth Soccer *Application to Host a Tournament or Games*. We agree that we will not modify or mark in any way original rosters or member passes; and will not register any player, coach, or team official or issue any member pass.

USE OF US SOCCER REGISTERED REFEREES: We agree that we shall use for all games only US Soccer registered referees who are in good standing (unless US Soccer has granted a waiver to allow the use of authorized referees from another country), and shall use a one- or 3-referee system. We intend to use a 3-referee system for the following age groups: _____ There will be an adequate number of US Soccer registered referees available in the area during the tournament or game dates to cover the scheduled games. TOURNAMENT PROCEDURES and RULES

(F.I.F.A. Rules apply unless amended below.)

1. Coaches must present rosters, team passes, medical releases, and guest player forms at least 30 minutes prior to their first game. Premier or select level teams are expected to play up a level.
2. Nonappearance at the start of your scheduled game will cost your team a forfeit.
3. The forfeiting team will be charged with a loss and no goals scored. The winning team will be awarded 2 goals and 3 points for a win.
4. No player is allowed to register with more than one team within an age group, and no player may switch from one team to another during the tournament. (exceptions may be given with permission of tournament director)
5. No player may play with a hard cast. (unless properly padded at discretion of referee)
6. There will be no refunds for nonappearance due to inclement weather or any other reason. Refunds will be provided only in the event the Tournament Committee cancels a division due to lack of participation.
7. Uniforms: Each team must bring an alternate set of shirts in case there is a conflict of colors. In the case of a uniform conflict the team listed first on the schedule is the home team and shall change uniforms. The use of shin guards by all players is mandatory. **All players must wear turf shoes or sneakers. No cleats permitted.** Players' uniforms must be similar and extra clothing will be discouraged but will be allowed at the discretion of the Referee. NO earrings or jewelry can be worn.
8. All rules are F.I.F.A. rules except these outlined herein.
9. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to modify the # and length of games.
10. Teams are guaranteed no less than 100 minutes playing time.
11. The start and stop of games will be signaled by the Field Marshal or their designate. There will be no time extension for substitution, time wasting, injury, tied games, or any other cause.
12. Substitutions shall be unlimited and may be on the fly. Substitutions may not enter until the other player is off the field.
13. There will be no off-sides.
14. Balls over the touchline will be thrown in. Corners will be taken.
15. On all restarts the opposing team must be at least 5 yards from the ball.
16. After taking possession of the ball, a goal keeper **IS ALLOWED** to throw or kick a ball past the center line that is struck from within his/her penalty area. This includes goal kicks taken by any player.
17. If the ball hits the ceiling the ball remains in play at the Referee's discretion. If the Referee determines a restart is required, the restart is an indirect free kick for the opposing team from the center line.

18. Slide Tackling is not permitted. A slide tackle shall constitute a foul resulting in an indirect free kick.

19. Intentional Heading is not permitted for the U10 and below age groups. This will constitute a foul resulting in an indirect free kick. The indirect free kick will be at the spot of the foul unless the foul is against the defending team inside their penalty area which then must be taken on the penalty area line parallel to the penalty line at the point nearest to where the infringement occurred.

20. Scoring: Points will be awarded as follows:

Win: 3 points

Tie: 2 points (other than 0-0 score)

Tie: 1 point (0-0 score)

Loss: 0 points

Forfeits: A team winning a game by forfeit shall be credited with a 2-0 win and 3 points.

In case of tie in the final standing within a division group:

a. In head to head play, the team that beat the other shall be placed ahead of the other.

b. The team that allowed the fewest goals shall be placed ahead of the other.

c. The team with the best goal differential up to a maximum of 4 goals per game shall be placed ahead of the other.

d. The team that scored the most goals shall be placed ahead of the other.

Note: "a" is not to be used if more than two teams are tied.

21. First and second place in U9 – U12 division will be presented with medals. Teams who do not place first or second in U9 and U10 divisions will receive participation medals. Championship t-shirts will be presented to first place teams in U13 and older divisions.

22. Player passes will be checked only at registration. Up to 2 guest players will be permitted. However, any coach has the right to challenge any player on the opposing team; the Referee must be notified prior to the completion of the game, and the player and his pass will be examined after the game. Any team using an illegal player shall receive no points for any game played up to the time the infraction is noted. Their opponents will be credited with a 2-0 win, 3 points awarded.

23. A player or coach who receives a red card is automatically ejected from the entire tournament. A player or coach who receives two yellow cards in a match is out of that match and the following match. A player or coach who receives three yellow cards during the tournament is out of the rest of the tournament.

24. Decisions of the Referees are final and not subject to appeal. The tournament Field Marshall shall have final say over anything that is not covered in these written rules.

25. Each team and player participating in the tournament does so at his/her own risk and agrees to accept all responsibility for any injuries. East Hudson Youth Soccer League, its officers, tournament officials, the Hudson Valley Sports-dome, AHA, any and all sponsors, and/or Kingston Area Soccer League (KASL) cannot be held responsible for any form of injury of any persons attending.

26. Additional information, material, and/or corrections may be issued on or before tournament day, including modification to the rules governing play and the schedule.

27. Any team found not to be in compliance with the described definition of teams from the Permission to Host form and tournament application will be required to forfeit their games.

28. Food and drink are prohibited on turf area. Only food and drink purchased at the Hudson Valley Sports-dome are allowed in the facility. Smoking and spitting are strictly prohibited throughout the facility. Coaches and players are responsible for the cleanliness of their team areas. All garbage is to be placed in appropriate garbage receptacles. Coaches are responsible for team/spectator behavior.

OTHER INFORMATION

All nonparticipants and spectators will be expected to observe the games in progress from designated viewing areas. Only coaches and players will be permitted on any turf/field surface. The Hudson Valley Sports-dome does not permit outside food or drink in the facility. The Hudson Valley Sports-dome concession stand will be in operation for purchases of food and beverages. **There will be a \$3 admission fee for all adults except coaches. This fee will be collected at the door. This fee will be going directly to The American Heart Association.**

RULES GOVERNING PLAY

F.I.F.A. laws will be in effect during the tournament with the following exceptions:

Law I – The Ball

All age groups through U12 will use a number 4 ball.

The U13 and older age groups will use a number 5 ball.

Law II – Roster

U9 through U11 can roster 14 players (2 guest players permitted per team)

U12 and above can roster up to 18 players (2 guest players permitted per team)

Law III – Minimum Players

Every team must have a minimum of 7 players for U8/U9 and U10, 7 players for U11 and U12, and 6 players for U14, U16, and U19; ready to start play within 5 minutes of the start of a game or the game will be forfeited.

Law IV – Field Players

U8/U9 through U12 will play 8 v 8 (includes keeper)

U13 and above will play 7 v 7 (includes keeper)

Law V – Substitutions

Substitutions shall be unlimited and may be on the fly except keeper substitutions. In event of substituting for a goalkeeper the referee must approve. Substitutions may not enter until the other player is off the field.

Law VI – Referees

The Field Marshal or their designate will keep the official game time.

There will be no protests allowed on judgment calls made by the Referee. The ruling of the Referee will be final.

Law VII – Duration of the Game

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to modify the #/length of the games. Teams are guaranteed no less than 100 minutes playing time. The start and stop of games will be signaled by the Field Marshal or their designate. There will be no time extension for substitution, time wasting, injury, or any other cause.

Law VIII – Start of Play

The team listed first on the schedule (home team) will kickoff

Law IX – FOOTWEAR

The Hudson Valley Sports-dome does NOT permit cleats! **All players must wear turf shoes or sneakers. No cleats permitted.**

Law X – CONDUCT & CLEANLINESS

The coaches are expected and required to ensure players and parents conduct themselves professionally at all times. The coaches will ensure that players and parents "clean up" after themselves. We thank you in advance for your cooperation in this.
