Mr. Cantu presented the Treasurer's report showing a balance of \$24,593.20 in our account after all monthly expenditures.

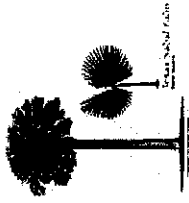
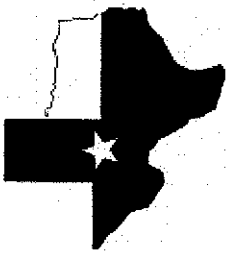
There was no New Business and on New Reports discussed National School Plant Management Conference to be held in Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

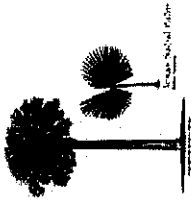
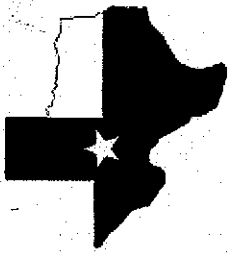

It is that time of year again when we are making plans to take our students on a well-deserved field trip. The students are working very hard to accomplish their goals this year. We will be going to the Coastal Center at South Padre Island and would like to take them to Bob's World in Los Fresnos for lunch.
