Many of the boys get very excited about raising the money as they know that with the more money brought in the longer they will get to delay getting back into the mix of off-season. In the past, we have had a lot of success with this fundraiser and have rarely had someone choose not to be a part of it. I have attached the letter they were all given along with the documentation sheet to keep track of the funds and where the money is coming from so we can acknowledge our supporters in the future. The boys were also given some schedule cards we had printed up that has all the home games on it which I encouraged them to give to all the people who donated to the program. Hopefully, these cards will be able to act as a standing invitation to the games and we can expect more support on our home field. We live in a great area with a great community that supports these young men and the programs they are a part of; I am hoping these guys will be able to reach out to that community to help raise funds for the many things the program needs to continue to take boys soccer to the next level.
