

JAMES MORRISON WILSON

1921 - 1998

Jim Wilson age 77, life long resident of the Elkton area, died Thursday evening, October 22, at his home after a long battle with cancer.

He was born April 19, 1921 at the home of his parents, the late Obed and Ossa (Morrell) Wilson in Chandler Twp.

After high school Jim served in the US Navy during WW II. On June 29, 1946, he was united in marriage to Lila M. Farver at the Chandler Presbyterian Church. She preceded him in death December 13, 1981.

He drove truck for Neeb Corporation from 1953 to 1961 when he took a position as custodian with the Laker school system, where he remained 26 years retiring in June of 1986.

Mr. Wilson was a member of the Chandler Presbyterian Church, past commander of the Elkton VFW, past member of the Elkton Lions and served as trustee on the Elkton village council for 6 years.

Surviving are his son, Richard of Elkton; his daughter, Jeannine (Richard) Erhlich of Lake Twp; his granddaughter, Lindsay; three brothers, Robert (Marie) Wilson of Pinnebog, Gerald Wilson of Unionville and Vernon (Marlene) Wilson of Caro and his sister, Eleanor Wilson of Elkton.

Preceding him in death were two brothers, John and Elmer.

Funeral services will be conducted 11:00 AM Monday, October 26, at the Chandler Presbyterian Church. Rev. Matthew Arneson, pastor will officiate with burial in Caseville Twp. Cemetery.
