*"Save women from Domestic Violence & Sexual Abuse"*

*The RAVE Project*

*From 500 churched women; 500 religious leaders for 15 years.*

*+ 1 in 5 couples in their congregation are violent*

*+ 83% pastors counseled at least an abused woman*

*+ 58% churched women helped an abused woman*

*+ 25% churched women offered women shelter in their homes*

*+ 95% women reported not heard a sermon on the subject of sexual abuse from the pulpit.*

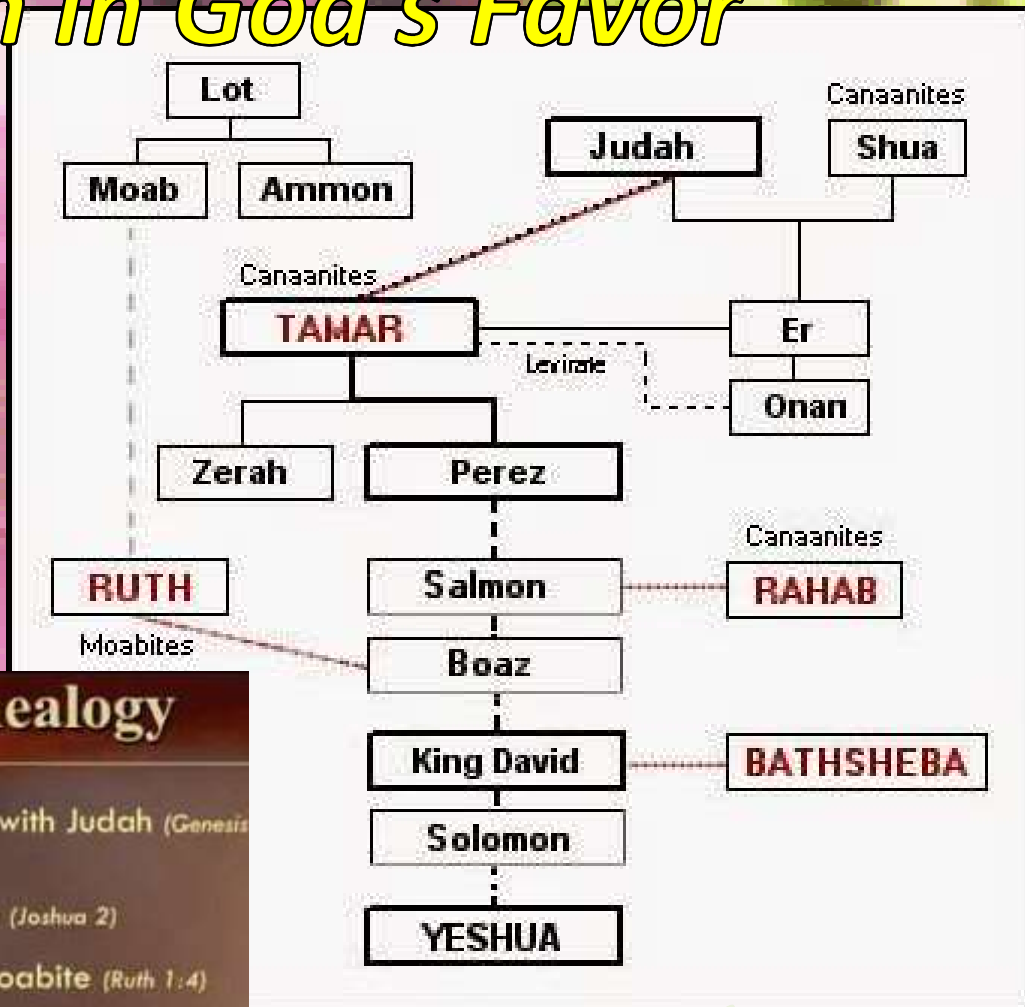

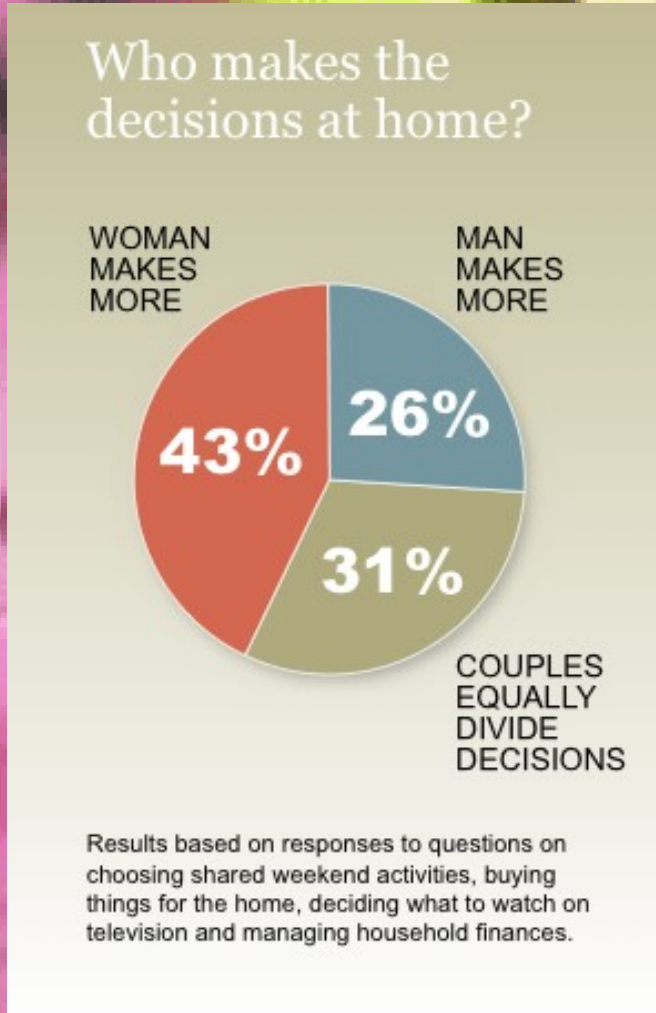
