Final approval for the seven was voted on and approved by the membership. New members were welcomed by the President. Dan Charles explained the point system and steps necessary to become a Reduced Rate member.

Dan Charles gave an update on Youth Shooting. Last session for the year will be on May 21<sup>st</sup>. Sessions will start again in October. For Youth Archery, there will be two more sessions, on May 14<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>. Youth Archery will start again in January.

Tony McClure gave an update on Ladies Night. The sessions are averaging 10-13 attendees. The next session is May 17<sup>th</sup> and will continue through June. He commended the ladies for their attention to safety.

Vic Gurinowitsch talked about the Conservation Camp coming up in June. The club will sponsor two attendees for the camp.
