UA/LOA Requests - Absence from Drill/LOA Requests: Any Sqdn member having been "UA" (unexcused absence) for two drills during the last three months may receive a warning e-mail. What Sailor liked spinach? Reply to gsmillermn@gmail.com with the answer. A third UA within any three months will result in disenrollment. Any request for a cadet Leave of Absence (LOA) must be made by the cadet PERSONALLY to the cadet's Squad Leader or division LPO and then approved by the CO. Any request for an excused absence by officers from a drill must be approved by the CO. LOA requests for officers also require approval by NHQ.

Correspondence Courses - Several cadets owe correspondence coursework in order to be advanced. *Not doing your coursework not only affects your advancement but it also negatively affects our Squadron on the annual inspection*. All correspondence courses to be graded should be e-mailed to LTJG Harty at <a href="michael.j.harty2@navy.mil">michael.j.harty2@navy.mil</a> at least 5 days prior to drill. You must use the answer sheets (NSCTNG 027). These are located on HomePort under the Administration tab under Training Forms. Your coursework will not be graded unless it is turned in on the correct form. Questions? Contact LTJG Harty at (417)619-4360.

**Petty Officer Advancement Examinations** - Notify LTJG Harty via e-mail <a href="michael.j.harty2@navy.mil">michael.j.harty2@navy.mil</a> at least 4 days prior to drill if you need to take a Petty Officer Advancement exam at drill.

**Callouts:** It is the **individual cadet's responsibility** to respond to the callout when the POM is published for a given drill. You MUST call your squad leader to confirm your attendance and understanding of the POM. Read the entire POM now so you will be able to answer your squad leader's questions if he or she calls.

**Off Limits:** Cadets are not to cross over to the Marine side of the building. This means the vending machines are off limits as well.
