## **If chosen to receive one of the scholarships, the applicant must consent to the required information:**

- ◇ You can meet with the Scholarship Committee via Zoom at a designated time or at an agreed-upon time between the scholar and the committee.
- ◇ Agree to attend the Memorial Scholarship Breakfast on the first Saturday in August.
- ◇ Agree to give a short speech of thanks, appreciation, and acknowledgment of the gift. (Don't worry, the committee will give you a template and suggestions for your speech.)
- ◇ Have decided what college or career training institute/trade school you would like to attend.
- ◇ Obtain an ID Number from a selected college or career training institute /trade school so a check can be sent to the institution.
- ◇ By the end of your first semester or no later than December 30, write a letter of thanks/gratitude to the Buffaloes Foundation, Inc. for the opportunity to earn the one-thousand-dollar scholarship.
