Unwanted Visitors? Speaking of wildlife, some residents have reported evidence of rodent activity in some of the yards. The best way to avoid having rodents is to keep your yard clear of fallen fruit, etc. Of course, you are permitted in your own yard to set traps, if necessary, or call an exterminator if you deem it

necessary.

The Backflow Saga Continues: Steve Rogers, Ron Yamato, Paul Strong and I attended the VOM Water Board meeting on January 17th. Residents of Creekside. Temelec and Chantarelle were present in great numbers. Steve and I were among those to speak at the meeting. After an hour, the VOM Board voted 5-0 to recommend that our three communities be granted a twoyear extension in order to comply with the current law governing the installation of backflow devices. This recommendation will be given to the California Water Board for their approval. We feel this is a step in the right direction, giving us more time to look at other options and technology. You've probably read what the Index Tribune has published on the topic and its impact on all of us. Hopefully in a short period of time we will know the outcome of our request and the VOM Board decision to assist us. In the meantime, if any Chantarelle homeowner wishes to receive his or her previously mailed check to Plumbing Service Company, you may request that your check be returned. Their

address is 6400 Elvas Ave, Suite B, Sacramento CA 95819. It is completely your decision whether to have your check returned or wait for the outcome of the VOM Board request.

New Signs: We are also working on new signage for our community entrances, as was mentioned at the last HOA meeting. We are currently exploring companies and options. This project includes replacing the letters on three entrance walls, two at Sebastiani and Arnold, and one at the Watmaugh entrance. The new signs will enhance the look of our Community.

The Rains Came: We hope the recent rains have not damaged your home or property, but those rains certainly have helped to ensure the life of our lawns, trees and other plants for the duration. **Traffic Report**: The two-way stop signs at South Temelec Drive and Avenida Sebastiani remain a safety concern. Blaring car horns and near misses are increasing in number. Drivers not familiar with the corner mistake this for a fourway stop, resulting in more danger. Previous requests for traffic studies have gone unheeded: I have contacted the Sonoma Sheriff's Office and I am awaiting a meeting to discuss this concern. In the meantime, be extra vigilant at that intersection.
