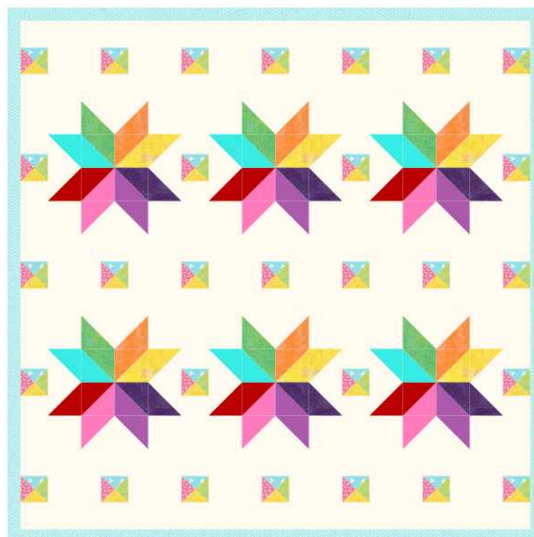


Savannah Stars

This quilt was designed to use the 10" finished star blocks and 2" finished quarter square triangle blocks that were completed in the Zoom class with Beth Helfter from www.EvaPaigequilts.com. See her website for more information on classes.

There are many techniques to make these two simple blocks. Use your favorite.

Required:

- 6 - 10" finished star blocks using 2 ½" finished half square triangles
- 29 – 2" finished quarter square triangles

Sashing requirements are very simple. Only two different size pieces to cut.

Cut from background

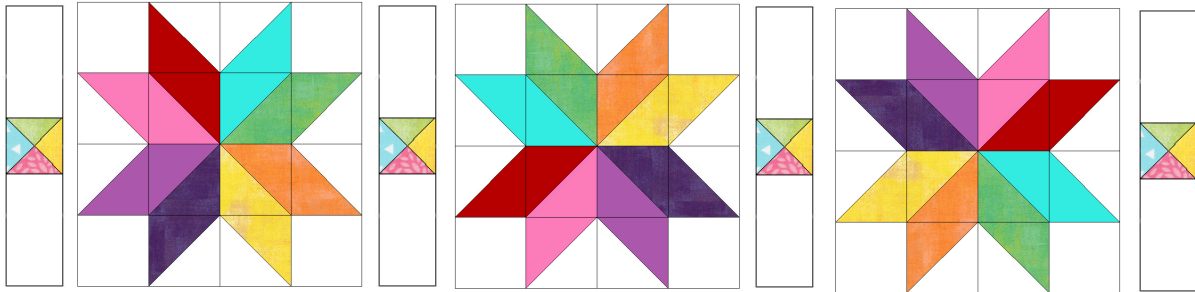
- Piece a - 6 @ 2 ½" x 38 ½" (I usually don't cut to the exact size. Oversize the cut (40") and mark the finished size with a pin). That way, if your seams aren't exact, you can adjust the size of the sashing.
- Piece b - 34 @ 2 ½" x 4 ½"

Putting it all together -

- 3 Quarter square triangle rows – the block alternates with sashing piece b.



- 2 Star rows begin with a quarter square triangle and sashing pieces b (on both sides of the quarter square triangle) and alternate with a star block and end with a quarter square triangle and sashing pieces b.



- Complete the layout with the sashing pieces a. Add border as you wish.
