How To Find Time To Pray During The Day

Ideally, we should go to Mass every day. For most of us, that's just not possible given our work schedule and the limited weekday Mass schedule most Churches have. If we can't go to Mass, we should find a quiet place and set aside time to pray every day. That's great if you can do it, but again for many it's just not practical. So how can you find a time and place to pray every day?

First, realize that in the eyes of God any place and any time is the perfect place and time to pray. Pray in the shower. Pray in your car. On the bus or train or plane. Extend your 10 Second rushed Grace before meals to a full minute of prayer. If you can take a five-minute break for coffee, you can afford to take a few of those minutes to pray. Reach out and connect with God. You'll find it more refreshing than a cup of tea or coffee. Say a few prayers before you chug down that cold brew with friends after work.

Try to pray throughout the day. Get prayers on your smartphone, notebooks or PC. Sign up for and pray the Liturgy of the Hours. It's free and can be accessed from your cell phone, notebook or PC. If you have a CD player in your car, get some prayer CD's, or Gospel Music, or even Bible Reading CDs. You'd be amazed at how comforting the Psalms can be after a long, hard and frustrating day at work or the office.

Find ways to pray during the day. Keep God in your life. And see what a difference it makes. God Bless!

Make Someone's Day Today

I was in the drug store (pharmacy) the other day and there was this long line of people waiting to place and to pick up prescriptions. It's the cold and flu season here. At the front of the line was an elderly lady who was proudly wearing some worn and threadbare clothing as if it was her best Sunday outfit. It probably was. Her medications cost several dollars and a number of cents, I want to say 56 cents, but the exact amount is not important. The point is, she simply did not have that extra 56 cents, which we all could see as she dumped the contents of her purse on the counter and looked for every spare penny hidden inside. Everyone in line was intently watching her struggle. After about a minute, I went up and handed her a dollar (I'll admit I was later embarrassed, when I realized I could have just as easily handed her a \$5 or \$10 bill). It was equally intriguing to watch the reactions of everyone else in line – while they were all happy that "someone" had come up with a solution to get the line moving again, none of them thought to offer this poor lady any help. It's too easy to stand by and watch than to participate.

And therein lies the point of this passage. You never know how much something little like a dollar, a smile, a simple sincere thank you, a helping hand or a kind word, can mean to a person. So little can often mean so much. So, the next time, don't just stand there being an observer, reach out and be a participant. Do that little something that makes a person's day. And you'll both be happier. God Bless!

Would Jesus Have Tweeted?

It's a question I love to ask Priests and Pastors. The answers are interesting and illuminating because the question drives home just how different present-day society and culture are from Biblical Times. All too often clergy like to pretend like we still live the simple lifestyles of Jesus' followers. While it is true that The Word and its lessons are timeless, to ignore the cultural changes over the last two millennia is to create a chasm between what pastor's preach and what people today experience in their daily lives.

That is not to say that the Bible is any less relevant, or true, or timely. It's the foundation of our beliefs.

But it does bring to mind questions like *would Jesus have Tweeted*. On the one hand scholars know of no recorded writings by Jesus. The written record of Gospels and Letters was prepared over the centuries by Jesus' Apostles and Disciples, and their followers and students. Who actually wrote the first Gospels will be the subject for future BLOGs, for today, from everything we know, Jesus did not.

Jesus certainly was knowledgeable enough that He could have written, so that leads some scholars to conclude that Jesus preferred to interact face-to-face and share His teachings by speaking not writing. On the other hand, Jesus gave His Disciples the mission of spreading The Word to all men of all nations.

Today, using technology such as Tweeting, TV, even emailing, or the Web, would be ways to spread The Word far and wide. That school of thought maintains that Jesus would have used every method He could to get his message out to as many people as possible. Writing was not a way to do that in His time because so few people could read and methods of copying and distributing writings were virtually non-existent. Documents were laboriously copied by hand and cached in libraries and religious buildings.

Today we have the luxury of worldwide instant communication with millions who can read what we write. So, whether you believe Jesus would have Tweeted, or not, do your part to spread The Word.

Don't Donate To SCAMS!

I watch Religious, Bible and Gospel Shows on TV. I find many are informative and inspirational. And most of them will ask you for money. Feel free to support your favorite shows but beware of SCAMS!

So how do you tell a SCAM from legitimate shows, fund-raising or telethons? Listen carefully to the message and look carefully at the presenter. If the presenter is wearing religious garb, comes from a well-known order or society like the Jesuits or St. Vincent de Paul and clearly identifies why they are asking for your hard-earned money, they are probably legit. Still, it never hurts to Google them and look for reviews. Once you send that check or give away your credit card number, you'll never get it back!

On the other hand, if the presenter is wearing a \$1000 silk suit and adorned with \$5000 diamond cuff links and a \$10,000 Gold Watch, and they are asking you to send the money to them, or their "Ministry", don't donate a dime! Switch the channel FAST so you don't drive up their TV ratings by watching them. If you watch these SCAMS, you're just helping their ratings rise enabling them to rip off more people.

Frauds will be full of Bible Quotes such as "sowing seeds" and "planting". They'll say you must give to God to get in return. They'll speak about tithing (I'll cover that topic in an upcoming Blog). And they will have people provide fake testimonials. Where in the Bible does it say you'll gain God's Good Graces by giving money to charlatans and frauds? Where does it say that by supporting Evil you'll be rewarded with anything but thanks from the Evil One? Don't do the Devil's Work! Switch the channel on SCAMS.

So the next time some slick TV Presenter tells you all your problems will be solved by God for giving them money, RUN as fast as possible away from that Evil. Your Donations and Tithes should be given to your Church or legitimate Charities. Don't support Evil. Give to Good. And God will Bless You for it!

- † Give A Mass. Most Parishes will let you dedicate a Mass or Service for a small donation. If you know someone, or a family, in great need, dedicate a Mass or Service for them. Prayer works!

- † Give A Prayer Card. Many of the ideas above do take money, and for many of us money is very short. When I go to my Catholic bookstore, named the *Carpenter's Shop* in honor of St. Joseph, if I have some extra change I pick up a couple of the small laminated Prayer Cards for 99 cents. I keep a few in my pocket and give them to those that need prayers. (*Note: this website has free downloadable prayer cards that you are free to print and use, click the PRAYER CARDS TAB*)

How Much Do You Know About The USA?

Many of those who visit this site are from around the world, Asia, Africa, Latin America and Europe. It occurred to me that they would like to know more about America. Not what you hear on the News is 30 second sound bites, but some real information they can relate to on a personal basis. Based on what they teach, or fail to teach, in American schools today, I felt even many of my US followers might find some facts on American History interesting. So I added this short BLOG on the USA today.

The first true Americans were Native Americans, often erroneously called Indians because Columbus thought he had landed in India. Settlement of America by Europeans really didn't start in any numbers until the 1600's. The English and Dutch settled what is now the East Coast and formed named Colonies. The French and Spanish sparsely settled wide territories along the Gulf Coast and major interior waterways. These Europeans, mostly in the Sothern Colonies, imported thousands of slaves to work their farms producing lucrative "cash crops" such as tobacco and later cotton. Except for the Spanish, most people were practicing Protestants.

By the time the 13 Colonies went to war with England in 1775, called the American War of Independence or American Revolution, there were over 2,000,000 people and several hundred thousand slaves living in America. Almost 85% of the white population was from Britain (including England, Ireland, Wales and Scotland), while 9% were German and 4% Dutch. As mentioned, most of the Spanish and French "settlers" lived in coastal and interior territories not part of the official 13 Colonies. America experienced unprecedented growth, its economy increasing 12 fold between 1700 and 1775. Interestingly, White American's had the highest standard of living in the world even back then and the Colonial Economy rivaled other nations.

Today, America has truly become a "Melting Pot". It's 326 million people making it the 3rd most populous country in the world behind China and India. In addition to Western Europeans that were the original settlers, today America has many people from Latin America, Asia, Africa and other countries across the world. Large immigrant populations from Italy, Ireland and Mexico have swelled the Catholic population in America to over 70 million, but Protestants are still the majority religion comprising over 50% of the population. Other major religions include Jewish, Hindu, Buddhist and Muslim. America's Economy, as measured by GNP, is the world's largest.

While I know that everyone reading this is not suffering from Mom's conditions of CHF and Cancer, this information will still prove useful to them and their loved ones. If other people have a richer and longer life, and if they can help their loved ones survive a serious illness in hospitals and nursing homes, then something good will have come from Mom's Story.

You will be able to tell from some of the events in Mom's Story, like the attacks on 9-11, that this book has been a number of years in the making. In truth, while I started writing this soon after Mom's Death, it was some years before I could bring myself to bear the pain of reliving many of the events depicted here. And while some medical procedures may have changed, and the public is becoming more aware of health issues, such as the dangers of eating too much salt, I believe that the most important messages in Mom's Story are timeless, so that even now she would want me to tell it.

What Has Man Missed In God's Message In The New Testament?

Is there a greater meaning and deeper meaning in the teachings of Jesus in the New testament? This is not about some secret hidden message or Bible code, rather it is about grasping the full meaning of what man has been reading teaching and preaching for the last 2000 years. Simply put, is there more to God's Message than we read in the Scriptures. What's Missing. What is the true meaning?

Christians themselves are divided on this question. Many believe in the doctrine of Sola Scriptura, that God's entire message is contained in the written word of the Bible. Still other adhere to Prima Scriptura, that the Bible is the primary source to which man must add reasoned interpretation and teachings. Roman Catholics believe that oral teachings (called somewhat confusingly "traditions") combined with the written Word form a body of knowledge called the Deposit of Faith. Fine, so there are different beliefs. What has this to do with man having missed God's message?

Let me provide an example. For those that say the entire message is in the text of the Bible my question is which text? There are dozens of translations and the bible is written in hundreds of languages. Let's take the Sixth Commandment. Thou Shalt Not Kill. Simple right? Not so fast. In various translations of the Bible this is written as;

- Thou Shalt Not Kill
- Thou Shalt Not Slay
- Thou Shalt Not Murder

The difference in meaning is not trivial, it is significant. Many Christians interpret the meaning as "not kill" and therefore are opposed to killing in self-defense and in the military. Some interpret "kill" broadly and maintain that it applies to all of God's Creatures including animals. Others interpret "slay" to mean man and do not apply it to animals. Finally, "murder" has an entirely different meaning and it is often this interpretation adhered to by people, police and the military that do not believe that taking a life in self-defense is a sin. I myself had discussions with priests before entering the military and was given this meaning. Sergeant York, the most decorated American of WWI originally applied for conscientious objector status, but ended up "killing" to defend himself and his other friends in the army. The fact that there is one text and one interpretation is simply not true. And in those multiple interpretations man has come up with multiple meanings and may therefore has missed God's true meaning. My life has been spent reviewing and rewriting history where the experts got it wrong, and Our Savoir has tasked me to put those talents to work exploring the true, and perhaps missed, meaning of The Word of God.

Questions (And Answers) of Faith ...

Some ask, if Jesus loves us, why does God permit hunger, sickness and war in the world? I ask why do we bring these unto ourselves? We have it in our power to end all wars, feed the hungry, and cure almost all sickness. When someone like my father dies of lung cancer, was it because God had forsaken him? Or because he smoked 3 packs of poisonous cigarettes a day? How much of the bad things in our lives do we bring on ourselves? How much of the killing, starvation, privation and devastation has the world brought on itself? The fact that mankind has made a mess of things doesn't in the least bit shake my Faith.

Perhaps it doesn't shake my Faith because I don't believe these horrors exist because Jesus has failed us, but because we have failed Jesus. We have failed to follow Jesus' teachings. The world has had two thousand years from the time of Christ to get it right and follow Jesus' footsteps, but even counting all Christians, not just Catholics, less than half the world follows Jesus today. And we have even seen that many of the various Christian religions differ in major beliefs from the Catholic Church that the Son of God founded.

The fault lies mostly with us, the Roman Catholics. Jesus intended us to be more than just Sunday Church Goers. An hour a week, \$20 in the collection basket, a prayer before bedtime and *Salvation Here I Come*. Really? *Do you honestly believe that?* Who do you think you are kidding? Not God. God knows. You are just kidding yourself and risking your eternal Salvation.

That's assuming you are a practicing Catholic. Many, many Catholics do not even go to Mass every week, give nothing to the Church and pray infrequently. I've talked to many experiencing a *"lapse of faith"*, and they almost always blame it on some life event, a death in the family, a divorce, the loss of a job. Times when they felt that Jesus Christ or The Church did not come to their rescue. Jesus never said; *"follow me and you will have a perfect life"*. But Jesus will help you survive the bad times.

In fact, all through Scripture and History we see where it is precisely those who follow Jesus through good times and bad, through happiness and sadness, through "thick and thin", that reap the rewards of Faith. The rewards of Salvation and Happiness in Heaven. Not riches and wealth on earth. Do you recall Jesus' words about the camel, the eye of a needle and a rich man getting to Heaven? If you think Jesus has abandoned you, then try praying longer and more often. *Try practicing more Faith.*

That's right, I said *practicing more Faith*. Try adding a few more minutes of prayer each day. Not for you, but for the sick and hungry and the homeless in this world. Put one more can of food into the Charity Collection at your Church on Sunday. Wear your Cross outside of your shirt instead of hidden inside it. We need active, not passive, Catholics. If those people born into other religions are not practicing Catholics when they grow up, it's the fault of those of us who are practicing Catholics. We need to be more active and aggressive in spreading The Word as Jesus told us to. We must be more visible in our good works and healing for all of mankind to see. *We must all embrace the New Evangelization!*

I Am Catholic ... *and proud of it!*

I promised a BLOG on why I am a Roman Catholic. Here it is. It does not quote Scripture, nor references. It is a blog of Faith. If you need to have support from the Scriptures and research the facts, I encourage you read and research for yourselves. But first search into your own Faith.

My first memories of the Catholic Church date from when I was very young and my mother became a single parent after my dad got sick and died from cancer. Society did not have all of the single parent support systems like it has today and times were very tough. The Catholic Church helped us and even gave my mom a job teaching in the Catholic School. Without The Church we could not have made it. Now I am certain many other religions have done the same thing, however the point for my Faith is that it was the Catholic Church that did it for us.

I always had an enquiring mind and as I grew up, I learned about my Protestant and Jewish friends' religions. In college I was exposed to even more religions through friends and readings including most of the Eastern Religions and even Islam. I was shocked to learn that many of my fellow students from some Communist Countries were even atheists. I could not contemplate a life without God. I found that some Protestants did not believe in the Virgin Mary and the Saints. But I had seen the workings of the Saints, especially St. Jude, in my own life during my childhood. Some believed that Communion was simply a representation of the Body of Christ. But I know that when I receive the Holy Eucharist at Mass it is really the consecrated Flesh and Blood of Christ. The Beliefs the Holy Spirit had Blessed me with did not fit any other religion.

Good reasons to be a Catholic. But I am Catholic for one simple reason. Because I believe in the Resurrection and Salvation of Jesus Christ and Roman Catholics are the only religion founded by Jesus Christ. One can even go further and state that Roman Catholicism is the only religion started by God. Judaism, Islam and all the Protestant religions were started by men. True, God had contact with men in the Old Testament, when he told Noah to build the Arc and when, as the Burning Bush, he spoke to Moses. But the origins of the oldest monotheistic religion, Judaism, are generally attributed to the kings and men of Israel. Truly men inspired by God, but men nonetheless. Islam was founded by the great prophet Mohamed, again a great man inspired by God, but Mohamed was nonetheless also a man. And there are many Christian religions and groups besides Catholics started by men. Great men, but nonetheless men.

Jesus Christ founded the Catholic Religion when he broke bread and shared wine with his Apostles at the Last Supper and said "do this in remembrance of Me", the first participation in the Sacrament of Holy Communion which has become the central rite of the Catholic Mass. Jesus made the Apostle Peter The Rock upon which he would build his Church and gave him the Keys to the Kingdom of Heaven. Hard to argue with that. While critics try to argue that "Roman Catholic" is only a name, a name that was first created by the Emperor Constantine centuries after Christ, the facts are that Constantine only put a name to The Church that had been in existence since the time of Christ. The Church founded by Jesus Christ in circa AD 33 and spread by His Apostles across what we now call the Middle East, and by later generations
