## Welcome to 5M.

It has been a hectic first fortnight in Year 5, but I think we are all settling in really well! There are new routines to get used to, and high expectations now we are in upper Key Stage 2. The children have come back to school ready to learn and progress is already being made.

As you probably know the class have a number of different teachers through the week, giving specialist knowledge to certain subjects. Here are some of the other things we will be covering this term...

<u>Maths</u>- place value including decimals, using the four operations, using line graphs, and reading timetables.

<u>English</u> – We are developing story writing, and reading Greek myths and legends. We will write reports which compare two factors, and write some poetry.

<u>Science</u> finding out about the Earth in space; then investigating forces.

<u>ART/DT</u> – The children will make Greek pots, then design and make a lighthouse.

<u>P.E.</u> – Gymnastics, circuits and outdoor games.

<u>R.E.</u>- We will focus on Judaism.

<u>ICT – We will produce a web site</u> about an aspect of Ancient Greece.



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
