UPPER SANDUSKY MISSION CHURCH

You are invited to be present in Upper Sandusky at 1:30 p.m. on Saturday, September 21 when The United Methodist Church returns a tract of land to the Wyandot or Wyandotte People.

The Mission Church was built in 1824 and used for worship by Wyandot/te Methodists until 1843, when a U.S. Government order removed the tribe from Ohio. In 1843 the Wyandot/te deeded the land to the Missionary Society of the Methodist Episcopal Church, forerunner of today's United Methodist Global Ministries, to protect the sanctity of the sacred burial grounds and religious site. The church was rebuilt in 1889 by Methodists in Upper Sandusky on the same site using the original stones. Members of the John Stewart UMC, coordinate use of the site and open it to the public for visitation through the summer months.

The observance will begin at 1:30 p.m. at John Stewart United Methodist Church (130 W. Johnson St.) followed by festivities outside at the nearby cemetery and old mission church.
