DISPOSAL INFORMATION

- Bulky Waste:** 2 items per trash day including furniture, metals and carpet cut into 4' lengths, rolled & tied (1 roll = 1 bulk item).
- No electronics, TVs, construction waste or items containing Freon.**
- Electronics:** ACUA does not accept electronics. Drop off electronics at the EHC Highway Garage on Esslair St & Chicago Ave, Mon-Fri—8 to 2 pm. Please don't call Public Works for pick up. acua.com/electronics
- Latex Paint:** Latex paint is not hazardous waste. Dried paint can be disposed of in the trash. acua.com/paint
- Batteries:** Alkaline batteries can go in the trash. Rechargeable, silver-oxide, lithium-ion, nickel-cadmium and lead-acid batteries should be taken to our Household Hazardous Waste drop-offs. acua.com/hhw
- Shredded Paper:** Cannot be recycled curbside, but can be brought to ACUA's Recycling Drop-off in EHT. acua.com/rcdropoffs

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Includes: leaves, grass, brush, branches and Christmas trees

- No bamboo, cornstalks, reeds, seagrass, or hay/straw bales.
- No plastic bags.
- Place yard waste in kraft bags or in properly marked containers.
- Bags or containers should not exceed 50 lbs.
- **SMALL** Brush/branches must be tied with twine & should not exceed 4' in length or 8" in diameter.
- **LARGE** Brush/branches are to be stacked neatly and left out to be chipped up by the city, there are no limits to length or diameter.
