Clarification on Exterior Improvements and Painting

Home Improvements

All improvements and modifications to the exterior of the house, exterior fixtures, and building site, and modifications that reduce vehicle parking space in the garage require review and approval by the Architectural Control Committee (ACC). Requests for review and approval are made on the form, *Request for ACC Approval of Home Improvement Project*. Submit the completed form to the management company to begin the review and approval process. Homeowner must receive approval in writing prior to beginning work on the project. The review and approval process by the ACC provide the opportunity to establish compliance with the deed restrictions (Declaration 2) prior to initiating the project and to "check and balance" the overall impact of the project on the aesthetic appearance and appeal of the community.

Exterior Paint Colors

The color of house paint, fixtures, and other materials (e.g., lanterns, facing stone, pavers) used on the exterior of each home requires approval of color choice by the ACC. Even if the plan is to repaint with substantially the same color used in the original construction, the work plan and specified color(s) must be submitted to the ACC on the form, *Request for ACC Approval of Home Improvement Project*. The review-and-approval process by the ACC is designed to preserve the beauty and color-coordinated harmony of the community, as designed by the builder.

Each home was painted at original construction with an overall color scheme that complements the color of the home's associated stonework and coordinates with the aesthetics of the community without duplicating the color of adjacent homes. Most homes have a three-part color palette (main stucco, trim stucco, accent wood) plus coordinated colors of guttering and downspouts. Garage door stain and front door stain are also coordinated with each other and with the color palette of the house. All paints and stains originally used are from the Sherwin Williams collections. If you have knowledge of the original paint colors, it is wise to record that for future reference, because faded colors are difficult to match. As stated in our Declaration 2 Article VIII, Section 8.16 Exterior Colors: "Unless otherwise approved by the Architectural Control Committee (ACC), each residence and other painted improvements upon each Building Site must be painted or repainted in substantially the same color(s) used in the original construction of same." However, a homeowner who desires to change the exterior colors of their house shall submit paint colors for ACC approval, at which time the color choice shall be reviewed to preserve the overall color scheme and accents, taking into account the color of the stonework and the color of the adjacent homes.

Fence Stain Color

All wood fencing throughout the community is cedar and shall be stained with the following color: Salem Red SW3018 Woodscapes acrylic exterior solid color stain (Sherwin Williams).
