



Affection & Sexuality

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. (Matt.6: 9-10) As an ambassador of Christ (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in Christ (John 15:4-5, John 6:56) and one with Him (John 17:22), we come into agreement with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), Jesus Christ, we give thanks to the Lord, the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for you and your family, for the saints, for the leaders that God has raised up on your behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy, so that Christ might make known to you the riches of His glory, we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall for you and your house (Ezek. 13:5); for all the brethren, all those called by the name of the Lord; for the leaders of this nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the well-being of God's people; all the people of this nation, and all men, so that you and your family may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. (1 Tim. 2:1-2) In the name of Jesus Christ, we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2). We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God! (Rom. 5:2) It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray for you and your family (James 5:16), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30), , and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight (Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). The words that Christ, through us, speaks to you and your family are spirit, and they are life. (John 6:63) Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Cor. 15:57)

As a fellow worker in Christ Jesus (Rom. 16:3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we lift up you and your entire house, all of your family, all of

your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time, all those by adoption, and all those by marriage, all your natural seed and all of your spiritual seed. Peace and mercy be upon you and your house. (Gal. 6:16) The Lord is King forever and ever (Ps. 10:16); You our God, our King from of old (Ps. 74:12), have heard the desire of the humble; You will prepare our hearts; You will cause Your ear to hear us. (Ps. 10:17) In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23) of Nazareth, by the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), may each husband render to his wife the affection due her, and likewise may she render to him the affection due him (1 Cor. 7:3), and the respect due him (Eph. 5:33). May you never doubt your love for one another, believing, for love never fails (1 Cor. 13:7-8). In the name of Jesus Christ, He who searches the minds and hearts (Rev. 2:23), in His name may you always greet each other with a kiss of love and may peace be yours (1 Pet. 5:14). Let you love each other as yourself, (Eph. 5:33) nourish and cherish each other as you love and cherish your own body (Eph. 5:28), and be joined together and become one flesh (Eph. 5:31). According to the riches of His grace (Eph. 1:7) the God of love and peace (2 Cor. 13:11) grant you and your spouse to not curse one another but bless each other with your mouth (James 3:10). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray you will greatly rejoice in the Lord, your souls shall be joyful in your God. (Is. 61:10) Let us worship and praise the Lord, for He is good, for His mercy endures forever. (2 Chr. 7:3)

In the name of Jesus Christ, the Branch of the Lord, beautiful and glorious (Is. 4:2), according to His excellent greatness (Ps. 150:2), the Lord bless you and keep you (Num. 6:24) so that love flourish between you and your spouse and you be kind to one another, never jealous or demeaning, nor rude, nor selfish and may you not be provoked or think evil of one another but bear all things, believe all things, hope all things, and endure all things (1 Cor. 13:4-7). Let neither you nor your spouse seek your own comfort, but each the other's well-being. (1 Cor. 10:24) In the name of Jesus Christ, a sure foundation (Is. 28:16), let Christ be your rock (Ps. 18:2) so that you and your spouse support one another for two are better than one, because they have a good reward for their labor. For if they fall, one will lift up his companion. (Eccl. 4:9-10) In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray, God, your God forever and ever; your guide even to death (Ps. 48:14), bless you and your spouse with the comfort of love, fellowship of the Spirit, affection and mercy; that you and your spouse have the same love, being of one accord, of one

mind, doing nothing through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind you both shall esteem the other better than yourself, looking out not only for your own interests, but also for the interest of the other (Phil. 2:1-4). May you lie down together and keep warm. (Eccl. 4:11) In the name of **Jesus Christ**, thanks to the name of the Lord (Ps. 122:4), according to the Spirit of holiness (Rom. 1:4) may you and your spouse walk in love (Eph. 5:2) and unity with all lowliness and gentleness, with long suffering, bearing with one another in love (Eph. 4:2) day in and day out. Peace be yours (1 Pet. 5:14). In the name of **Jesus Christ**, the true vine (John 15:1), may your marriage abide in **Jesus Christ** and bear much fruit (John 15:5), a threefold cord that is not quickly broken (Eccl. 4:12). May the two of you withstand the oppressor, and the threefold cord, you and your spouse joined with **Jesus**, will not be easily broken. (Eccl. 4:12) The Lord preserves all who love Him. (Ps. 145:20) Praise the name of the Lord! Blessed be the name of the Lord from this time forth and forevermore! Praise the name of the Lord from the rising of the sun to its going down! (Ps. 113:1-3)

In the name of **Jesus Christ**, you are washed, you are sanctified, you are justified in the name of the Lord **Jesus** and by the Spirit of your God (1 Cor. 6:11), so in His name let you and your spouse rejoice together. Husbands, let your fountain be blessed, and rejoice with the wife of your youth. As a loving deer and a graceful doe, let her breasts satisfy you at all times and always be enraptured with her love. (Prov. 5:18-19) May you ravish each other's heart with one look of your eyes. (Song. 4:9) In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you both will set your spouse as a seal upon your heart, as a seal upon your arm; for love is as strong as death. (Song. 8:6) Many waters cannot quench love, nor can the floods drown it. (Song. 8:7) In the name of **Jesus Christ** may the Lord your righteousness (Jer. 23:6) keep you and your spouse sexually pure in mind and body, and close the door to anything lustful or illicit that seeks to encroach upon you and your marriage. For this is the will of God, your sanctification: that you each should abstain from sexual immorality (1 Cor. 6:18); that each of you should know how to possess your own vessel in sanctification and honor, not in passion of lust. (1Thess. 4:3-5) Let you and your spouse flee sexual immorality and glorify God in your bodies and spirits. (1 Cor. 6:20) In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your spouse possess your own vessel and your marriage in sanctification and honor. (1Thess. 4:4) For the ways of man are before the eyes of the Lord, and He ponders all his paths. (Prov.

5:21) He who loves purity of heart and has grace on his lips, the Lord *Jesus Christ* will be his friend. (Prov. 22:11) Let you and your spouse rejoice in your Maker; let you be joyful in your King! (Ps. 149:2) The Lord loves those who follow righteousness. (Prov. 15:9) Bless the Lord from this time forth and forevermore. Praise the Lord! (Ps. 115:18)

In the name of *Jesus Christ*, grace might reign through righteousness to eternal life through *Jesus Christ* our Lord (Rom. 5:21); therefore in His name let you and your spouse be an example to your children and your children's children in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity (1 Tim. 4:12). May your children abstain from sexual immorality; that each of them should know how to possess their own vessel in sanctification and honor, not in passion of lust. (1 Thess. 4:3-5) According to the exceeding greatness of His power (Ps. 79:11, Eph. 1:19, 2 Tim 1:8), may our Lord, our great and awesome God (Dan. 9:4), keep your children from being unequally yoked together with an unbeliever. For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has light with darkness? (2 Cor. 6:14) When the time is right may God join your children and your children's children together with the perfect mate and therefore what God has joined together, let not man separate. (Mark 10:9) May the Lord bestow these same blessings on all of your children and their spouse. In the name of *Jesus Christ*, the Prince of Life (Acts 3:15), in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that the Lord will pour His Spirit on your descendants and His blessing on your offspring. (Is. 44:3) In the name of *Jesus Christ*, the bread of life (John 6:48), may the Lord give you increase more and more, you and your children. May you, your spouse and your children be blessed by the Lord who made heaven and earth. (Ps. 115:14-15) In the name of *Jesus Christ*, the light of the world, the light of life (John 8:12), may the Lord perfect that which concerns you and your spouse and your children; Your mercy, O Lord, endures forever; do not forsake the works of Your hands. (Ps. 138-8) Your truth, O Lord, endures to all generations. (Ps. 100:5) In the name of *Jesus Christ*, the good shepherd (John 10:11), may you and your spouse leave an inheritance to your children's children (Prov.13:22) rich in the fullness of God (Eph. 3:19) and the love (Eph.3:17) and knowledge of the Lord *Christ Jesus* (Eph 1:17). The Lord be magnified! (Ps. 40:16) The Lord shall reign forever - Our God, to all generations. Praise the Lord! (Ps. 146:10)

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your family, your time and your space, by the blood of the lamb (Rev. 7:14, 12:11). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), Jesus Christ, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed. The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein. (Ps. 24:1) The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness, He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it. For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. (Col. 1:16) You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created. (Rev. 4:11) As a fellow worker in Christ, a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God. As a vessel of mercy, so that Christ might make known to you the riches of His glory, we claim you and all the people of the earth as the inheritance (Eph. 1:18) of our Lord Jesus Christ. By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most High, and the time has come for the saints to possess the kingdom. (Dan. 7:22) Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and Christ will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin. And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now our salvation is near. (Rom. 13:11) Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it. (Is. 34:1)

Concerning the things we pray for you and your house, we come into agreement with you (Matt. 18:19), with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1), being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14), and with confidence (1 John 5:14) in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask our Father in heaven in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the resurrection and the life (John 11:25), believing that you and your descendants receive all we ask for you (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14),

petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to you and your descendants according to His word (Luke 1:38) and what we have asked shall be given to you and your house (Luke 11:9). The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations. (Ps. 33:11) God is watching over His word to perform it (Jer. 1:12) and it shall not return to Him void but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it. (Is. 55:11). "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." Says the Lord God Almighty (Ps 89:34). Let us praise Your great and awesome name, O God, You are holy! (Ps. 99:3) In ***Jesus'*** name so be it. For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever. (Matt. 6:13) Amen
