Position Opening

Mountain Roots is hiring three Core Group Leaders this summer that will have the opportunity to work closely with a small staff team and an awesome group of kids. Our Core Groups (Oaks, Maples, and Dogwoods) are age-based groups that travel throughout the day camp experience together. Mountain Roots is offering nine weeks of day camp this summer in Brevard, NC at 3 different locations. We work with a range of populations through our various programs. As a mission-driven organization, one thing that all of our programs have in common is striving towards this common goal: to provide discovery and outdoor learning experiences with a focus on environmentally responsible and community centered living. We offer programs that revolve around leadership and group development; nature; and the arts. Summer 2017 core group leaders will have the opportunity to work with all 9 weeks of our multi-faceted Day Camp as well as the opportunity to work on program development and assessment. Core Group Leaders will take part in at least one week of staff training in early June.

Qualifications

Core Group Leaders are directly responsible to the Mountain Roots Executive Director. Our CGL's may range from a variety of backgrounds, but must have certain interests and qualifications. These include the following:

- > A bachelor's degree in a field related to outdoor education, or the equivalent in work experience
 - Possibly a degree in outdoor leadership/recreation/education; elementary education, the arts and sciences, non-profit management, and other related fields
- Experience (and/or interest) working with youth ages 4-18
- ➤ Ability to manage a group safely and confidently
- Interest in working closely with a small staff team within the core group (3-5 individuals) to help provide the best experience possible for our campers
- Wilderness First Responder (preferred), Wilderness First Aid, or Standard First Aid / CPR
- Experience working with individuals with varied backgrounds, abilities, and cultures
- Interest in gaining specific youth development work skills, and administrative experience
- An excitement about serving others in an outdoor setting through challenge and experiential education, as well as a belief in environmentally responsible actions and education
- Competent and comfortable leadership and teaching styles (and an interest to develop these)
- Interest in program and curriculum development preferred
