Local Author – Filomena Tripp

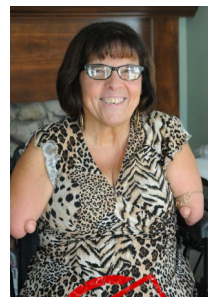
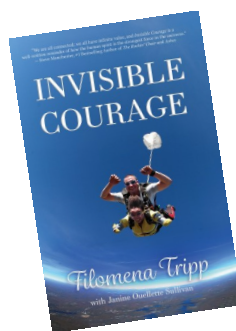
Tuesday, February 6th at 6:00
