ATTENTION SENIOR PARENTS:

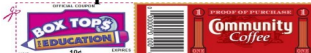

INNOCENT EYES. ...things once seen, can NEVER be unseen!

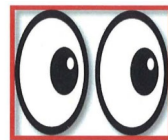
Parents,

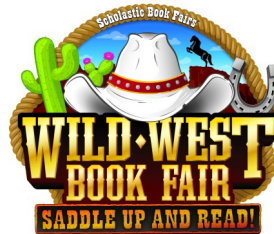
TEAM UP!
