

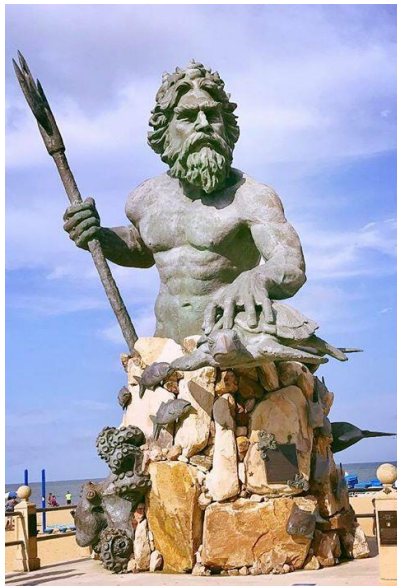

Explore the Virginia Beach Boardwalk, Beach and Boardwalk Art Show

The Virginia Beach Boardwalk and Beachfront is a beautiful place. It is three miles long on the Atlantic coast and has plenty of benches to relax and enjoy the incredible views. The boardwalk is about 28 feet wide and also has a separate bike path. **The Boardwalk Art Show**, 2021 dates to be announced soon, is one of the oldest and best outdoor fine art shows on the East Coast, and next year will mark the 61st Anniversary. Consistently ranked in Sunshine Artist Magazine's Top 40 fine art shows. This four-day festival attracts collectors and artists from across the nation.



King Neptune Statue at Virginia Beach Boardwalk

Located at 31st Street, this mighty statue can be seen from a mile away! Walking up to King Neptune for the first time is extraordinary, and is an experience you won't forget. At first glance at the King, you will notice the godly strength of his whole body. His left hand with a tight grip on the shell of a huge loggerhead turtle and holding a large triton in the right hand makes the statue seem larger than life. **The entire statue is about 34 feet high!** After scoping out the King, you will notice all of the other friends that surround him. All along the bottom of the statue are starfish, fish, and even two dolphins that are placed behind him.

Cape Henry Lighthouses

The Cape Henry Lighthouses are filled with history and are must-sees when visiting Virginia Beach. The lighthouses are on the Fort Story naval base. Visitors over 16 must present a valid ID at the security gate. The Old Cape Henry Lighthouse dates back to 1792 as part of the first federal construction project signed



off on by President George Washington. The newer lighthouse, known as the Cape Henry Lighthouse, was built in 1881 a little more than a football field away from the original. Both Cape Henry Lighthouses are National Historic Landmarks and are on the U.S. National Register of Historic Places. The original lighthouse offers incredible views of the Chesapeake Bay and the Atlantic Ocean.

Military Aviation Museum

The Military Aviation Museum in Virginia Beach is a cool place to visit. It is on 105 acres and home to one of the best private collections of World War I & II military aircraft. Many of the airplanes are still in use during airshows and demonstrations. It is incredible to see all of these beautiful planes that bring history to life. It is a must-see.

Mount Trashmore Park

The main mountain, Mount Trashmore, now 60 feet in height and 800 feet long, was created by compacting layers of solid waste and clean soil. Recognized for its environmental feat, this former landfill features a water-wise garden that boasts xeriscaping which requires minimal water.
