Scholarship Categories and Eligibility Requirements

(Unless otherwise stated, **all applicants must be permanent residents of Baltimore County** but may attend school in any county or state). Students may apply for more than one scholarship, but are only eligible for one award. Please submit a separate application for each scholarship. Students are not eligible to win the same award in consecutive years.

College Student Book Award - \$2,500

This scholarship will be awarded to a current or incoming college student. The GPA requirement is 3.0.

Entering Freshman Scholarship - \$2,500

This scholarship will be awarded to a first-year freshman entering an institute of higher education in the fall of 2019. The GPA requirement is 2.75 with demonstrated outstanding contribution and leadership in community service and/or an extracurricular activity.

HBCU Outstanding Scholar Award - \$2,500

This scholarship will be awarded to one outstanding scholar attending an HBCU currently or in the fall. The GPA requirement is 3.25.

Outstanding Community Servant Award - \$3,500

This scholarship will be awarded to a student demonstrating superior community service. The GPA requirement is 2.5 with an outstanding record of achievement in community involvement, volunteering or other service to the community.

Precious Pearls Award - \$2,500

This scholarship will be awarded to a current or former participant of the Upsilon Epsilon Omega debutante program. The GPA requirement is 2.75. *There is no residency requirement for this award.*

The Refinery Entrepreneurship Award - \$2,000

This scholarship will be awarded to a female undergraduate or graduate student with an interest in IT or Entrepreneurship. The GPA requirement is 2.75.

STEM Scholar Award - \$2,000

This scholarship will be awarded to a student planning to or currently majoring in a STEM field (Science Technology Engineering and Mathematics at a four-year institution of higher learning. The GPA requirement is a minimum 3.0 (preference will be given to candidates with a 3.5 GPA) with a superior academic record in STEM courses and a declared STEM major.

Travel with a Purpose Academic Travel Awards (2) - \$250 and \$500

This scholarship will be awarded to two (2) current college students to support an already planned/approved study abroad or other academic travel experience. The grade point average (GPA) requirement is 2.75 with proof of approved upcoming academic travel.

UEO Family Scholarship - \$2,500

The applicant must be a child (including stepchildren and legal wards) of a **current financially active member** of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., Upsilon Epsilon Omega chapter. The GPA requirement is 2.75. *There is no residency requirement for this award.*

UEO Former Presidents' Leadership Award - \$1,000

This scholarship will be awarded to a current college student (second semester freshman or higher at the time of application) who is in a leadership position (officer, chairman, event coordinator, etc.) on their college campus or in their community. The GPA requirement is 2.5.

UEO Student Programs and Mentoring Award - \$2,500

This scholarship will be awarded to a current or former participant in any Upsilon Epsilon Omega student program (TIA, ASCEND, etc.). The GPA requirement is 2.75. *There is no residency requirement for this award.*

Uplift and Empower Bar Study Stipend - \$350

This stipend will be awarded to a recent law school graduate who is preparing to sit for the Bar Examination in the fall. The student must hold a Juris Doctor degree and be a current resident of Baltimore County.

Verdina Y. Showell Award for Excellence (Medical/Legal Studies) - \$2500

This scholarship will be awarded to a student committed to careers in the Medical (e.g. pre-med/medical school) or Law (e.g. pre-law/law school) fields. The GPA requirement is 3.3 with a record of high academic achievement, completed coursework in either area, and community involvement in either area.

Note: All students who are awarded a 2019 scholarship will be required to submit proof that they meet all requirements for the award (including residency, enrollment status for fall 2019, and GPA), before funds are released. Additionally, all winners will be required to provide an official transcript before awards funds are released.

Instructions

Please read all instructions carefully. **Incomplete applications will not be considered.** Applications are due via email **no later than 11:59 PM on March 15, 2019**. Please note that application submission is electronic.

- **Step1**: Obtain a transcript from your high school or college. *If you attended another high school for your junior year*, or you attended another college for at least 3 semesters, please obtain a transcript from your former and current schools. You may use an unofficial transcript. However, **all scholarship winners will be required to submit an official transcript before award funds are released.**
- **Step 2**: Request **1** recommendation. Your recommendation may be from a teacher/professor, administrator, counselor, mentor, community leader, sports coach, supervisor, extracurricular leader, pastor, etc. Please have the recommender complete the recommendation form that is included in this package OR write a personal recommendation letter (no more than one page in length). Recommendation letters should be on official letterhead OR must provide the recommender's title, address, phone number, and email address.
- Step 3: Complete the application and essay. You must complete a separate application <u>and</u> essay for each scholarship for which you are applying. Please type your responses. Handwritten applications will not be accepted. You (and a parent if you are under 18) need to sign the application.
- **Step 4:** Complete the application cover page. Please submit a **separate cover page for each scholarship** for which you are applying.
- **Step 5**: Scan all documents to create **one PDF file for each application**. The FedEx store, Office Depot, Staples, or your school career office or guidance counselor should be able to assist if you are unfamiliar with how to create a PDF file. Please note that no other file formats will be accepted (Word, JPG, etc.)
- **Step 6: E-mail your completed application package(s) before the March 15th deadline** to UEOscholarships@gmail.com. Please include all application packages in one email. All documents must be received via email no later than 11:59PM.

Your completed application package will consist of the following (in order):

- 1. Application cover page (please use a separate cover page for each scholarship)
- 2. Application Questionnaire
- 3. Essay (be sure to answer the appropriate essay for the scholarship for which you are applying)
- 4. Completed recommendation form/letter (you may use the same letter of recommendation if applying for more than one scholarship)
- 5. Transcript
- 6. Final statement

Application review: Incomplete or late applications will not be reviewed. We will complete our initial review of applications in mid-April. Your application package will be scored based on academic record, written content, grammar, creativity, and your recommendation letters. We will invite the students with the highest scoring essays/applications to submit video interviews **between April 20th and May 5th**. Winners will be notified no later than May 25, 2019. **Due to the high volume of applications we receive, non-selected students will not receive an official notification.** We will announce the recipients no later than May 30, 2018 **via our website www.akaupsilonepsilonomega.org.**

Entering Freshman Scholarship	Past life challenges can be used for future success. Describe a time when you faced a challenge or failure. How did it impact you? What did you learn from this experience? How has this experience prepared you for your first year of college?
HBCU Outstanding Scholar Award	Select an HBCU graduate whose life demonstrates triumph over circumstance and prejudice to build a life of accomplishment. Why did you select this person? Which of their accomplishments is most inspiring to you? What part of their story most resonates with you?
Outstanding Community Servant Award	What do you feel is one of the most important community service needs in Baltimore County? Why? What are the ways that you think individuals and organizations can best address this need?
Precious Pearls Award	Discuss your thoughts on the #metoo movement. Do you feel that women are now more empowered to report harassment and inappropriate behavior in the school and work settings? Do you feel that academic institutions support students who are victims of such behavior?
The Refinery Entrepreneurship Award	Explain the importance of female entrepreneurs in today's society.
STEM Award	Where do you see yourself professionally and personally in 5 years?
Travel with a Purpose Academic Travel Award	Describe how you think the world views American students in your generation, what you plan to do while abroad to either uphold or change those views, and how you plan to help make America stronger.
