-James Madison had a 675-590 yard edge vs Georgia Southern but were -3 in TO's and lost 45-38 as 13-point favorites.

-Ohio only had a 383-333 yard edge in their 19-point win vs Western Michigan as the Broncos had 6 turnovers!

-Baylor had a 590-500 yard edge but lost by 3 vs W. Virginia as they were -2 in TO's.

-Miami, FL had a 458-257 yard edge but only beat Virginia Tech 20-14 as the Hokies scored a couple of 4Q TD's down 20-0.

-Oklahoma had a 701-430 yard edge but only won by 10 vs Kansas.

Bad Beats

-Navy scored a long-TD with :14 left before halftime when it looked like they might have to settle for a FG. The Midshipmen also benefited from an inadvertent whistle on a punt that led to a TD in the 3Q. Finally, Navy went 75 yards in 16 plays scoring a TD with 2:31 left to cut the lead to 40-27. After forcing a punt, they went 80 yards in 13 plays scoring another TD with :09 left for the back-door.

Games in Rotation Order

Wednesday, October 19th

APPALACHIAN ST 36 Georgia St 26. Both teams are coming off a bye and both have disappointed so far this season. Obviously, App St is the better team with a +1.22 ypp margin vs a stronger schedule than Georgia St (+0.1 ypp). We don't see much value on the side but do lean OVER.

Thursday, October 20th

GEORGIA TECH 24 Virginia 22. We've downgraded UVA big time in year one under Tony Elliott as the Cavs are 1-5 ATS (-9.6 ppg). Georgia Tech has already fired their coach but interim Brent Key has the Yellow Jackets off back-to-back wins. Keep an eye on the status of GT QB Jeff Sims. That was one of the reasons why we bet UVA on Sunday.

SOUTH ALABAMA 25 Troy 22. We think the winner of this game wins the West Division of the Sun Belt as both teams are much improved. The two teams are similar in ypp margin (Troy No. 27, South Alabama No. 28). SA is +8 in TO's. We haven't seen much movement here as far as the side. No bet for us.

Friday, October 21st

Tulsa 32 TEMPLE 20. Tulsa comes in off the bye after getting humiliated by Navy. Speaking of humiliation, Temple might know a thing or two about that after a 70-13 loss on National TV to UCF last Thursday. Pass.

WESTERN KENTUCKY 29 Uab 28. Two sneaky good teams and the winner we think likely plays UTSA in the CUSA championship game. While neither has played a tough schedule, both teams rank in the Top 20 nationally in ypp margin, ypg margin and ppg margin. We bet UAB +3 on Sunday but we just felt it would close a tick lower off a key number.

Saturday, October 22nd

2★ Kansas St (plus the points) TCU 29 Kansas St 28. We like the spot here for Kansas St. The Wildcats come in off a bye while TCU has been through a gauntlet the last month playing cross-town rival SMU, blow out Oklahoma, ESPN College Gameday in Kansas and last week's 2OT come-from-behind win vs Oklahoma St. The Horned Frogs aren't Ohio St or Georgia when it comes to depth. Anything above "3" is worth a bet on K-State.

ARMY 33 UL-Monroe 23. We know Army is 1-5 ATS this season and they are a bit banged up but we like them here. They have the big ypp margin edge (No. 65 vs No. 111). ULM is facing the option in the middle of a tough conference stretch and the Warhawks defense has been struggling in recent weeks.

MIAMI, FL 35 Duke 23. Miami is just 1-5 ATS (-8.0 ppg) under first-year coach Cristobal. However, QB Tyler VanDyke is starting to heat up with 496 and 351 pass yards the last two weeks. Plus, the Hurricanes were more dominant than the final last week. Duke is off a OT game vs GT two weeks ago and a close game vs rival NC last week. How much do they have left in the tank playing an 8th straight week?

2★ Texas A&M 27 SOUTH CAROLINA 22. Both teams come in off a bye and need this win to establish momentum down the stretch. A&M has played the much tougher schedule. We think South Carolina is getting too much love for beating a Kentucky team without QB Will Levis. We like the Aggies and the OVER.

RUTGERS 26 Indiana 24. Rutgers is the better team statistically but Indiana has played the tougher schedule. The Scarlet Knights do come in off a bye, are finally healthier at QB and have a new OC. Indiana also runs a ton of plays so we lean towards the OVER here.

OHIO ST 39 Iowa 9. Both teams come in off the bye. It should be no surprise that Ohio St is No. 1 in our power ratings as the Buckeyes are No. 1 in ypp margin (+290), No. 1 in ypp margin (+3.6) and No. 1 in ppg margin (+33). As good as Iowa's defense is, the Buckeyes allow less ypp. Huge edge on the offensive side of the ball with Ohio St's No. 1 yards per play (8.1) compared to Iowa's No. 130 (4.1). We thought the line was fair.

WAKE FOREST 38 Boston College 20. Both teams off a bye but a tale of two different seasons. Wake has exceeded expectations while BC has struggled with a banged up OL. We bet UNDER 64 and still lean that way.

LOUISVILLE 28 Pittsburgh 27. If you're wondering why Louisville has flipped to favorite here, QB Malik Cunningham looks like he will play after missing their last game. Both teams are off a bye and both have disappointed a bit this year. If the line went to Louisville "-3" we'd bet Pitt but as of now, no play.

Central Florida 33 EAST CAROLINA 28. ECU comes in off the 4OT thrilling win over Memphis while UCF has extra rest after crushing Temple last Thursday. We understand the early money on the OVER but felt the total got too high and the market is overreacting to last week's final scores. Lean UNDER.

Byu 33 LIBERTY 25. This game features about as big of a strength of schedule disparity as any game this time of year. BYU is +1.0 in ypp margin while playing the No. 31 toughest schedule (according to Sagarin) while Liberty is +0.9 in ypp margin playing the No. 134 toughest schedule. Charlie Brewer might come back for Liberty but he could be rusty. We like BYU here.

Houston 29 NAVY 25. Houston might have saved their season in their last game vs Memphis. The Cougars do have extra time to prep for the option coming off the bye. Navy got a ridiculous "back-door" cover vs SMU last week (see bad beats on page 1). We lean towards Houston here but didn't bet it on the openers.

2★ Buffalo (plus the points) Toledo 31 BUFFALO 26. We think Buffalo has been underrated ever since they lost to FCS Holy Cross. They've covered 4 straight games. Meanwhile, Toledo beat us on these pages last week somehow rallying from a 21-point deficit and covering more than a TD spread. Their final scores have not matched their box scores in recent weeks. That gives us value on the Bulls at "+7" or more.

CENTRAL MICHIGAN 31 Bowling Green 23. Both teams have been inconsistent so far this season. CMU is much better statistically than their 2-5 record indicates as they are +26 ypg. Meanwhile, BG is No. 122 in ypp margin, No. 121 in ypp margin and No. 120 in ppg margin. We lean CMU even if they are without RB Nichols (the backup had 160 yards last week). We also like the OVER.

KENT ST 40 Akron 23. The Wagon Wheel rivalry has seen Kent St win 3 straight in blowout fashion. After playing the nation's toughest non-conference schedule, the Golden Flashes have struggled in MAC play including blowing a big lead at Toledo last week (much to our dismay on these pages). We lean dog and UNDER.

MIAMI, OH 27 Western Michigan 20. Both teams come in off disappointing upset losses last week and are their bowl hopes may rest on a win here. We backed WMU on these pages last week and they had 6 TO's vs Ohio. Miami is the statistically superior team (No. 92 vs No. 119 in ypp margin) and we trust them more than WMU to bounce back.

2★ Northern Illinois 35 OHIO 30. We like Northern Illinois here for a few reasons. The teams have played similar strengths of schedule yet NIU is better in ypp margin (+6.6 vs -91.6), ypp margin (-0.2 vs -0.6) and ppg margin (-1.6 vs -3.8). And remember most of that has come without their starting QB Rocky Lombardi who missed 3.5 games. He returned last week and the Huskies crushed EMU. Meanwhile, Ohio was +4 in TO's vs Western Michigan.

JAMES MADISON 31 Marshall 20. Is Marshall still celebrating that upset win over Notre Dame? It looks like it as they've failed to cover their last 4 games by 15.6 ppg. Now they face a JMU juggernaut that is No. 3 in the country in ypp (+231) and is angry off a misleading upset loss. With that being said, it looks like you're starting to pay premiums if you want to back JMU.

OLD DOMINION 32 Georgia Southern 31. Both teams come in off big outright upset wins last week. ODU easily cashed on these pages while GS took down the JMU power-house. We know it's not popular but our numbers said called for us to bet an UNDER in a Georgia Southern game at 68.5 and so far the market agrees.

CLEMSON 33 Syracuse 19. Statistically Syracuse is the superior team. The Orange are +164 ypg, +2.0 ypp and +23 ppg while Clemson is +78 ypg, +1.0 ypp and +19 ppg. So why is Clemson a big favorite here? Well, the Tigers have played the tougher schedule. Also note-worthy is two of Syracuse's signature wins this year vs Purdue and NC State come with an asterisk. Purdue was banged up and the Cuse were fortunate while the Orange also played NC State with a back-up QB last week.

WYOMING 23 Utah St 20. If this line looks a little "fishy" to you note that Utah St could be playing a 4th string QB in this game (see page 1 for full details in the injuries). That news stinks because we feel Wyoming is an overrated team. The Pokes are 4-3 but are -91 ypp! Pass for now.

COLORADO ST 26 Hawaii 21. Hawaii may have figured some things out after the bye week under first-year coach Timmy Chang. They've covered their last two games by a combined 45 points including last week's upset over Nevada. Meanwhile, Colorado St remains very banged up at QB. We didn't bet this yet.

Fresno St 27 NEW MEXICO 17. Fresno finally got their first cover of the season last week in a surprising upset win over San Jose St. Speaking of surprises, New Mexico was upset by in-state rival New Mexico St. Jake Haener remains out for Fresno. We actually lean with the home dog.

San Jose St 32 NEW MEXICO ST 12. How does San Jose St respond after the upset loss to Fresno last week? Also how does New Mexico St handle success after a big upset win over arch rival New Mexico? We wanted to back San Jose here but the number is too expensive especially at such a low total.

BALL ST 30 Eastern Michigan 29. We bet both of these teams under their season win total and both have exceeded expectations. We bet OVER 53.5 on Sunday but don't see any value left after the big move. We're passing at the current numbers.

NOTRE DAME 37 Unlv 14. Can you lay big numbers with a Notre Dame that is extremely limited at QB and WR? The Irish have already lost outright as a big favorite twice under Marcus Freeman and the locals aren't happy. Meanwhile, UNLV is really banged up at multiple positions. If QB Doug Brumfield can go, the Rebels are the side. If not, pass. We do lean OVER.

OREGON ST 38 Colorado 14. The Buffaloes off a bye got their first win and cover of the season with an OT upset of California as 15-point underdogs. Still, Colorado is dead-last in ypp margin (-188), ypp margin (-2.3) and ppg margin (-23.7). A lot of points to be laying with a backup QB for Oregon St most likely. Pass.

Rice 31 LOUISIANA TECH 28. Rice has been super impressive this season at 5-1 ATS covering by an average of 11.1 ppg. That's No. 1 out of any team 5-1 ATS or better. Meanwhile, Louisiana Tech is No. 117 in ypp margin, No. 110 in ypp margin and No. 113 in ppg margin. We lean OVER.

STANFORD 30 Arizona St 26. Stanford has played the nation's toughest schedule so far (according to Sagarin). The Cardinal should be feeling pretty good about themselves after the upset win over Notre Dame last week. However, note it looks like they will be without their leading WR for awhile. On the other side, Arizona St is off a bye after a big upset win themselves. QB Emory Jones should return. Our ratings say Stanford here even if the spot isn't the greatest.

Washington 33 CALIFORNIA 26. How does California respond after the embarrassing upset loss to Colorado last week? Meanwhile, it could be tough laying more than a TD with this Washington defense that's allowed 39 or more points in each of the last 3 games. We lean OVER.

OREGON 39 UCLA 33. This is the first Top 10 matchup in the Pac-12 since 2018 and the first for UCLA since 2001. Both teams are off a bye and both teams offenses have the edge over the opposing defenses. UCLA DL Latu leads the nation in sacks but Oregon has allowed only 1 sack all year. We like the experience edge at HC for UCLA's Chip Kelly who returns to Eugene but need a "+7" to get to the window.

UTSA 40 North Texas 29. Last year North Texas ended UTSA's 11-0 start so the Roadrunners will have revenge on their minds. This is the 8th straight week UTSA is playing but they have one extra day of prep and only played FIU last week (bye on deck). A lot of money on the OVER so far but we lean UTSA.

Texas 34 OKLAHOMA ST 28. Will Ok St QB Spencer Sanders play? He's been playing through a shoulder injury and there are rumors swirling about his availability. We've seen Texas go from -1 to -6. The Horns offense should be able to take advantage of a weak Oklahoma St defense. Keep an eye on the wind forecast too.

ALABAMA 41 Mississippi St 19. The last 7 times Nick Saban has come off a loss, he is 7-0 SU winning by 31 ppg and 7-0 ATS covering by 13 ppg. Last year Alabama was off a loss to Texas A&M and they beat Mississippi St by 40. In fact the combined score of the two Mike Leach vs Nick Saban matchups is 90-9. Now you understand why Alabama is laying 3 TD's.

LSU 33 Ole Miss 30. That was a huge win by LSU in the Swamp last week. QB Jayden Daniels delivered his best game with 349 passing yards, 3 TD's while adding 3 more TD's on the ground. They're taking on an unbeaten Ole Miss team that is facing their toughest test so far. Let Vegas help you. The unranked Tigers are favored over the No. 7 team. The early week money is on LSU (including us).

BAYLOR 34 Kansas 26. Kansas will likely have their backup QB again here in Jason Bean who has performed well the last 6 quarters and started a bunch last year. Baylor might also be playing a backup QB after Blake Shapen was KO'd last Thursday. Keep an eye towards not only the injury report but the weather report as 20-plus mph wind is in the forecast.

TEXAS TECH 37 West Virginia 30. We think Texas Tech is underrated. The Red Raiders are +117 ypg despite playing the No. 4 toughest schedule in the country. They are coming off a bye and could get QB Tyler Shough back (we also like Behren Morton). West Virginia had a big win vs Baylor but it was misleading. We gave out Texas Tech -4 on the Sunday Night VIP and the market has agreed.

Cincinnati 32 SMU 28. Cincy is coming off a bye but there are concerns with QB Ben Bryant and WR Tyler Scott. Head coach Fickell did say both are hopeful to play. Meanwhile, SMU suffered a really bad beat last week vs Navy. Provided Bryant plays we lean Cincy who is No. 5 in the country in ypp margin.

TULANE 34 Memphis 26. Tulane is 6-1 ATS this season covering by 6.7 ppg. Not only are the Green Wave in the AP Poll Top 25 for the first time since 1998 but they are also in the Top 25 in ypp margin, ypg margin and ppg margin. We question how much Memphis has left in the tank after the Houston finish two weeks ago and the 40T thriller at ECU last week.

MISSOURI 36 Vanderbilt 21. Missouri comes in off a bye while Vandy comes in off the physical beat down loss at Georgia. Despite a 2-4 record (Vandy is 3-4) the Tigers have been much more competitive as they are +43 ypg while Vandy is -147 ypg. Like many other games in CFB on Saturday. Keep an eye on the wind.

Southern Miss 25 TEXAS ST 22. Two teams that have been improved this season Southern Miss we saw coming into the season, Texas St not so much. Southern Miss has played the tougher schedule and is No. 67 in ypp margin while Texas St is No. 100. That's why they've flipped to road favorite.

MARYLAND 32 Northwestern 20. First and foremost, you have to check the status of Maryland QB Taulia Tagovailoa who was banged up in last week's game at Indiana. Maryland is No. 18 in ypp margin while Northwestern is No. 112. However, with the Wildcats off a bye and in their preferred underdog role, we lean NW.

CHARLOTTE 37 Fiu 24. Don't look now but FIU is starting to show some life including a cover last week vs UTSA. We expected FIU to be bad this year, we didn't expect Charlotte to be No. 130 in ypp margin, No. 126 in ypp margin and No. 126 in ppg margin. Tough laying points with the worst defense in college football as Charlotte ranks dead last in ypp, ypp and ppg allowed.

WISCONSIN 27 Purdue 26. Wisconsin really disappointed us last week losing outright to Michigan St. Did they just get that one-game interim bump vs Northwestern? Generally speaking, we think Purdue is under-valued in the markets but can't get to the window here unless we see a "+3".

Florida Atlantic 28 UTEP 25. FAU has played the tougher schedule and is statistically the superior team (-0.1 in ypp vs -0.5). However, we bet UTEP on the Sunday openers at +4.5. The Miners are off a bye while FAU continues to struggle covering under Taggart 9-17-1 ATS. Anything above "3" is worth a bet on UTEP.

3★ Boise St 24 AIR FORCE 23. We like Boise here for two big reasons. First, Boise St has extra time to prep for the option off a bye week. Boise is also fundamentally a different team than what they were a month ago. QB Hank Bachmeier transferED out and new QB Taylen Green (6-6 215) gives them a running threat. Also Boise has a new OC in Dirk Koetter (former Boise, Arizona St, Tampa Bay Bucs HC). That's an upgrade in both areas for Boise...while the market originally thought it was a downgrade. Don't believe us? Boise's high point this year was 327 yards vs UT Martin...Since the changes, they put up 450 yards and 443 yards vs San Diego St and Fresno St. The 316 rush yards was the most rush yards allowed by San Diego St in any game in 5 years!

PENN ST 25 Minnesota 18. Both teams have QB injury issues with Tanner Morgan and Sean Clifford questionable. The downgrade from Morgan to the backup is bigger than Clifford to his backup Drew Allar, who was a 5-star recruit. Also if Minnesota has to play a backup, a "White-Out" night game in Happy Valley is the last place you'd want to make your first start.

San Diego St 23 NEVADA 16. Both these teams are a shell of what they were in 2021 as we've downgraded both significantly. Tough laying points on the road with a San Diego St offense that ranks No. 119 in ppg. We do lean OVER though.

UL-LAFAYETTE 29 Arkansas St 23. ULL is playing better as of late including last week's outright upset as a 10.5-point underdog at Marshall. ULL is No. 78 in ypp margin while Arkansas St is No. 118. We didn't bet this game on Sunday and the market hasn't moved much at all. We don't see value. Pass.

Week 8 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

For the past six seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game on Wednesday. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 421-355-12 (54%) clip! So far this season those games are 25-19-1.** That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots or if there are late-week injuries. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the 6 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **Miami, FL -9.**

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

Thursday, October 20th

ARIZONA 23 New Orleans 21. Important game if either one of these teams has any playoff aspirations moving forward. The Saints controlled the line of scrimmage vs Cincinnati last week but had some red zone issues. Meanwhile, Arizona had four fourth-down failures in the loss at Seattle. New Orleans is +0.3 in ypp margin while Arizona is -0.8. However, the Cardinals have played the tougher schedule (No. 13 vs No. 27). The line seems right to us so we could only look towards taking New Orleans +8 in a teaser.

Sunday, October 23rd

DALLAS 28 Detroit 21. Dallas won the box score last week vs Philadelphia but note they were chasing down 20-0 early. Meanwhile, Detroit comes in off a bye. As of Wednesday, Dak Prescott will practice today and there is hope that he will return for this game. Dallas has the huge defensive edge (No. 3 vs No. 32 in ypp) and Dak should give the offense some juice if he returns. With that being said, we're currently not involved.

2★ JACKSONVILLE 24 N.Y. GIANTS 19. The Giants continue to defy the box score as they were out-gained 406-238 and were -3.2 in yards per play but somehow upset Baltimore last week to move to 5-1 SU/ATS. They are No. 27 in ypp margin playing the No. 26 ranked schedule while Jacksonville is No. 9 in ypp margin playing the No. 12 schedule. Now you see why the 2-4 team is favored and one of our best bets this week.

TENNESSEE 22 Indianapolis 21. Tennessee is fresh off a bye and did beat Indianapolis 24-17 (+4) just 3 weeks ago. However, the Titans are dead last in ypp margin (-1.4) despite their 3-2 record (that makes them overrated in our opinion). Meanwhile, Indy is off back-to-back wins and covers to save their season. We lean with the Colts but prefer them in a teaser.

CINCINNATI 26 Atlanta 21. Obviously, the Falcons have been the biggest surprise of the season so far at 6-0 ATS. They've been an underdog in every game but have found a way to win 3 of them outright including last week. The Falcons were +3 in TO's and got a fumble return TD. Meanwhile, Cincinnati got a win in New Orleans as QB Joe Burrow was sharp. That's now 4 straight covers for Cincy. We wanted to fade Atlanta in this spot but the number just isn't there for us.

BALTIMORE 26 Cleveland 19. Baltimore is 3-3 SU but the Ravens are No. 5 in ypp margin despite playing the 6th toughest schedule. Last week, they had a 406-238 yard edge vs the Giants and were +3.2 in ypp margin but lost. A +3.2 ypp usually screams 3-TD win. Meanwhile, we cashed fading the Browns in their blow-out loss to New England. They've now failed to cover in 3 straight games. Make it 4 straight.

Tampa Bay 26 CAROLINA 16. Obviously, there is some trouble brewing in Tampa with the Bucs 3-3 SU and failing to cover 4 straight games. Is Tom Brady completely dialed in for the first time in his career? Are there locker-room issues? Meanwhile, Carolina had a bad 4Q that sunk our best bet on them on these pages last week. A respected market influencer took Tampa -10 earlier this week but we just can't do it right now with this offense.

Green Bay 25 WASHINGTON 19. Much like Tampa, Green Bay is struggling right now with 3 straight non-covers. The Packers were -1.2 in ypp margin in the shocking 17-point loss to the Jets at TD-favorites last week. They are exactly 0.0 in ypp margin while playing the No. 22 schedule. Sounds average to us. Meanwhile, Washington has extra rest off the win vs Chicago which was very misleading (outgained 392-214). The Commanders are -0.8 in ypp margin and were -1.7 in ypp last week. Lean OVER.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

N.Y. Jets 20 DENVER 19. The Jets are 4-2 SU this year despite being at least a 3-point underdog in every game. Unlike the Giants, we don't think this is "smoke and mirrors". They are +0.2 in ypp margin despite playing the No. 9 schedule. They also played a few games with Joe Flacco as their QB. Thanks to the No. 2 defense in ypp, the Broncos are No. 4 in ypp margin. However, they're on a short week and we're hearing whispers that Russell Wilson might not play here. That's why this line is down to "pick-em".

LAS VEGAS 27 Houston 20. Both teams come in off a bye. The Raiders are much better than their 1-4 record as they are +0.1 in ypp margin despite playing the 3rd toughest schedule. Houston has exceeded their low expectations (3-1-1 ATS) but the Texans are still -0.8 in ypp margin (No. 28). We thought we would be on Las Vegas here but again the market is all over this one. Lean OVER.

Kansas City 25 SAN FRANCISCO 24. The 49ers are better than their 3-3 record indicates as they are No. 2 in ypp margin (No. 2). They have played a weak schedule and are arguably the most banged up team in the league right now. Meanwhile, Kansas City is off the loss to the Bills last week. The Chiefs have played the toughest schedule and are No. 5 in ypp margin. We lean 49ers but would like to see them get a couple more players back this week.

L.A. CHARGERS 27 Seattle 22. Seattle is a bit underrated as far as we're concerned. They are 0.0 in ypp margin which makes them an average team albeit they have played a weak schedule. The Chargers are a big overrated at -0.5 in ypp margin. Not sure we can justify the 6.5-point spread in this game.

2★ MIAMI 26 Pittsburgh 17. A lot of QB uncertainty in this one but let the point-spread tell you something. It looks like the Dolphins will see the return of Tua Tagovailoa after he's missed the last two games. Miami is +0.2 in ypp margin (No. 13) despite playing the 2nd toughest schedule and Miami has actually had to play 3rd string QB Skylar Thompson. Meanwhile, the Steelers fresh off the upset of the Bucs are still No. 31 in ypp margin. We like Miami.

Monday, October 24th

NEW ENGLAND 24 Chicago 16. The Patriots have been super good to us the last 3 weeks cashing best bets on these pages all 3 weeks. They are No. 5 in the NFL in ypp margin (+0.5) and backup QB Bailey Zappe has performed well. Chicago is off a misleading loss to Washington last Thursday where they had a 392-214 yard edge. Still, we worry about Justin Fields going up against Bellichick. Tough laying this kind of number with such a low total but we love the Patriots in a teaser.
