**2 Samuel 12:1 – 6**

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3. **v.6 c.f. Matthew 7:2, Luke 6:37, 1 Cor. 11:31.** What do these verses teach us about judging others in their sin? \_\_\_\_\_

4. Notice what God had done for David in **verses 7 - 8**... What does that tell you about God's thoughts toward David... toward us in general? \_\_\_\_\_

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5. **V. 9 – 10** There's an old saying, "What goes around comes around." How does this apply to these two verses? Have you personally witnessed that happen in the lives of those you interact with? Give an example. How does that apply to us? \_\_\_\_\_

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6. **V. 11 c.f. Luke 12:3, Numbers 32:23** David thought he was sinning in secrecy when in fact something else was going on... what? \_\_\_\_\_

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7. **Psalms 51** What was David's focus in the Psalm? \_\_\_\_\_

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8. **V. 13 c.f. Psalm 36: 1 – 4** Contrasting the two verses, what is it that gains God's favor? \_\_\_\_\_

9. Contrast v. 15 with v. 24. Why the difference in phraseology? \_\_\_\_\_

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10. v. 23 c. f. Deuteronomy 1: 39, Isaiah 7:16 What do these verses seem to indicate regarding a child who doesn't fully understand sin and their responsibility for it? \_\_\_\_\_

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**2 Samuel 12: 26 – 31**

11. v. 26 – 28 Where was David supposed to be? What do these verses reveal about Job? \_\_\_\_\_

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12. What does this passage reveal about God's mercy in spite of David's sin? \_\_\_\_\_
