## Letters from Students

*Thank you for sending me the Bible study. I have recently indeed given my life over to Jesus Christ, and as the Bible knowledge seeps in, pain flows out. There is not enough room for the one in the world and my love for an awesome Father, who gave me another chance and His love for me.*

*These lessons are really great, but what I enjoy even more is that when they come back, they are great for references, because I can study these over again and also use them for the Bible study in the Unit, plus you sent me a pamphlet “Why Not Talk to God,” and they are very useful for studies—also for great references.*

*All I need is God’s strength to help me through all my trials and disappointments. The love of God is all I want. Jesus died through faith; I have salvation in Him.*

*God can do everything. He gave us Jesus, His only Son, for us and the heavens above and worshiped God. Teach us to be like Christ and not be afraid to be a Christian.*

*Thank you for your prayers and for having me in your group. I have turned down many Bible studies throughout my incarceration, and I don’t really know what compelled me to even look through this one, but when I did, I noticed something different. . . . So I want you to know I am going to apply myself to this Bible study and looking forward to the next set of lessons.*

*I wish to be obedient. I realize all my troubles have come from disobedience and lack of faith: selfishness and lack of self-control. I am excited to be understanding and feeling like life really isn’t so hard as I thought if I have Christ. I can do this!*
