EVENTS: LECTURE BY PROFESSOR BELA G LIPTAK

ISA Delhi, in association with NTPC Ltd, hosted a talk by Prof. Bela G Liptak, an eminent personality in the field of Instrumentation and Automation, also regarded as the father of modern-day Control and Instrumentation. The program was held at Power Management Institute (PMI), NTPC on 12th January, 2008. Prof Liptak was accompanied by his wife Mrs. Máetha Liptak.

Prof. Liptak's speech focused on environmental issues and alternate power sources. His solution was based on the concept of Hydrogen based fuel cell and its evolution. He set the agenda with a prophetic élan "Today's question is not a 'why' or 'how'. It is only 'when'." To start with, the instrumentation fraternity looked uncomfortable with the topic, which explicitly is not focused on their subject. But that's what Prof. Liptak precisely wanted. He wanted them to come out of their comfort zone and venture into other areas. The controls should invade the chemical process of a cell, to enter electrical process for the parameter. We should take the lead and not be led. The future of instrumentation lay there, he emphasized.

The event was co-chaired by Executive Director, NTPC Dr. R.R. Sonde and ISA Delhi President Mr. M.P. Singh and attended by a large numbers of C&I executives of NTPC and other organisations.
