George J. Hunt, 82, of Pigeon, died Tuesday morning, June 6, 2006, at Courtney Manor in Bad Axe. He was born May 2, 1924 in Addison to the late George and Fannie (Wiggins) Hunt. On October 11, 1945, he was united in marriage to Irene S. Farnum in Dryden.
