- Mass Cancellation During Inclement Weather The following policies are in effect for Sacred Heart when inclement weather threatens: On mornings when there is a school Mass, if there is a **2 hour delay the Mass will be at 1:30 p.m. IF school is** cancelled, the Mass is CANCELLED. If school is cancelled on a day when Mass is in the evening, please listen to the radio or call the Parish Office to check to see if Mass is cancelled for that evening. Father Chris will make a decision by Noon on those days. Whenever a county/city within the Diocese of Toledo is placed under a Level 3 Snow Emergency, the Catholic Churches will cancel Masses. Catholics in that region there-fore, are dispensed from their obligation to attend.
