
#### President's Statement – Need for Committees





Change of Management Company





- Board and new management company have established a strong and effective working relationship
- Change of Management Company resulted in a review of processes and policies of the Club
- Identified out-of-date or missing policies
- Board has created a plan to address these in 2023

# Treasurer's Report



## Treasurer's Report

- 31 memberships sold, 4 reclaimed, and 9 available
- Actuals 4.8% over budget (↑ \$9.9k). Drivers for divergence as follows:
  - Pool operations costs ↑ \$9.8k
  - Insurance costs higher ↑ \$3.3k
  - Management company costs ↑ \$1.9k
  - Sale of additional memberships reduced total overage  $\checkmark$  \$5.6k
- Dues increased by \$32 to \$512 (个 6.7%)
  - Costs increased due to inflation
  - Labor cost increased due to minimum wage changes; ↑ from \$11 per hour, to \$12 per hour
- Reserves fully funded

# Pool Update



## Pool – Committee Status

- Has three active members
- Held ad-hoc meetings in 2022 due to limited agenda
- Plan to have a published meeting schedule in 2023

## Pool – Achievements for 2022

- Active pool season over 2022 summer
- Active coordination and use of pool by the Hiddenbrook Hurricane Swim Team
- New electronic entry system (MOKO) to confirm membership and entry onto pool grounds
- Addressed maintenance items;
  - Repair plaster in wading pool
  - replaced lane lines
  - purchased new umbrellas
- Held a morning fitness swim program
- Regular food trucks

## Pool – Plans for 2023

- Develop master "Pool" plan to address various upgrade options, to include:
  - Expanded picnic area
  - Expanded deck area for seating
  - Expanded wading pool
- Address maintenance items, including:
  - Replacement of round tables (on deck) and broken picnic tables
  - Replacement of exterior and interior water fountains
- Establish a picnic area policy
- Establish a lap swimming policy
- Investigate robotic pool cleaners
- Offer a morning fitness swim program
- Offer a water aerobics program
- Continue food truck program

- Held ad-hoc meetings in 2022 due to limited participation
- Plan to have a published meeting schedule in 2023
- Committee needs volunteers

## Tennis – Achievements for 2022

• Large tree limb hanging over tennis court cut

## Tennis – Plans for 2023

- Develop tennis only membership terms & conditions
- Power wash courts prior to summer season
- Address minor cracks on tennis courts
- Establish a Tennis ladder (like in 2021)
- Establish a Pickleball ladder
- Investigate the creation of a reservation system to deconflict increased use in Summer months, as well as, any potential "camps", etc.
- Look into options for a Tennis Clinic for children
